**AMELIA:** I can't wait!



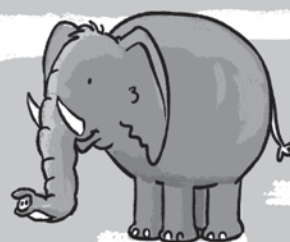
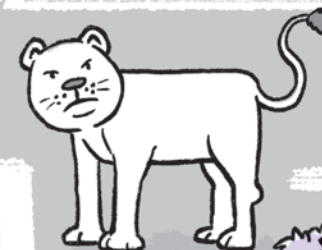
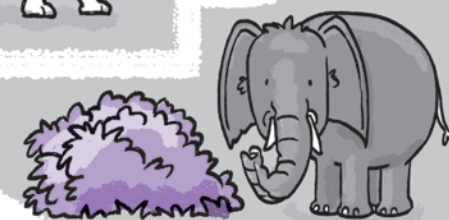
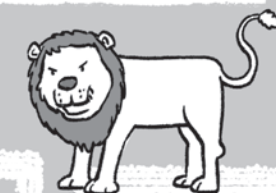
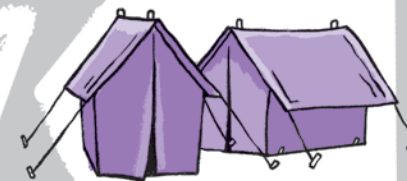

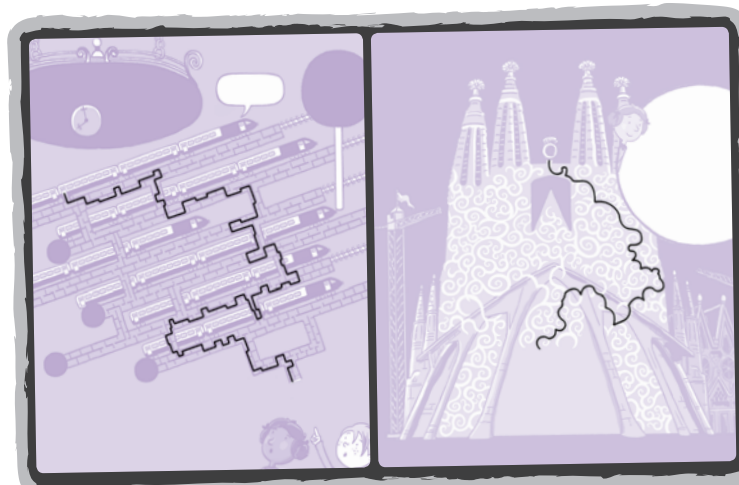

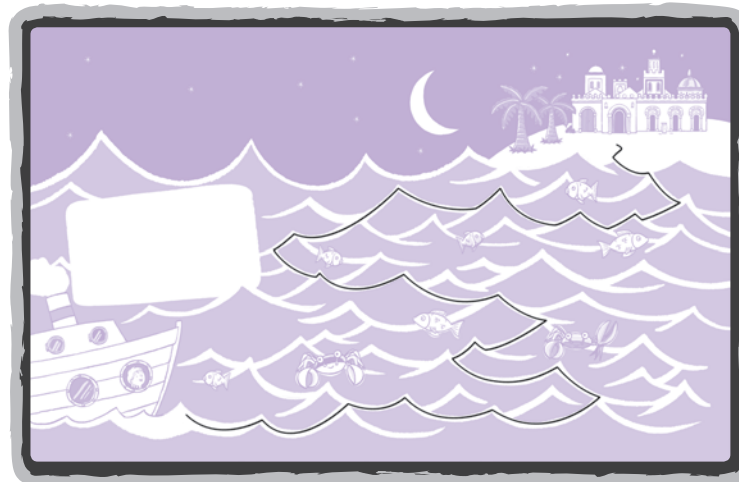

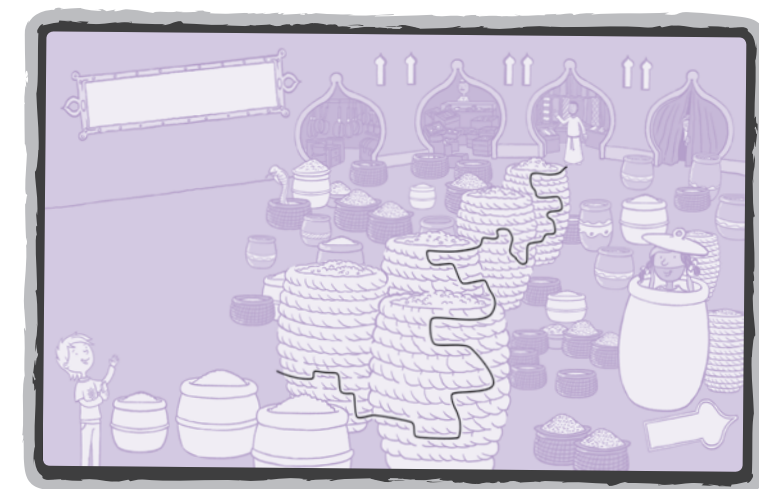
