LITERARY EDINBURGH

Writers' Museum (L8) Manuscripts and memorabilia belonging to three of Scotland's most famous writers: Robert Burns, Sir Walter Scott and Robert Louis Stevenson.

Word Power (P11) Long-established radical bookshop specialising in political, gay and feminist literature.

Scottish Poetry Library (S6) Award-winning building holding some 30,000 items and hosting literary events.

Taxi Edinburgh's black taxis can be hailed in the ordered by phone (extra 80p charge) or picket of the many central ranks. The minimum charge (£3.10 at night) for the first 450m, then 25p for subsequent 188m - a typical 2-mile trip acros centre will cost around £6 to £7.

ARRIVING IN EDINBURGH

Edinburgh Airport Bus service 100 runs from Waverley Bridge (one way/return £4.50/7.50, outside the main train station, via Haymarket End every 10 minutes from 4am to midnight a minutes through the night. Trams run from the the city centre (one way/return £5.50/8.50.3 every six to eight minutes from 6am to midnig taxi to the city centre costs around £20 and ta to 30 minutes.

Edinburgh Waverley Train Station The main t is Edinburgh Waverley, located in the heart of the city between the Old Town and New Town. Trains arriving from, and departing for, the wes also stop at Edinburgh Haymarket station, which is more convenient for the West End.
