
BRITISH ISLES

LONDON C3
Immersed in history, London's rich seams of eye-opening antiquity are everywhere. The city's buildings are striking milestones in a unique and beguiling biography, and a great many of them are instantly recognisable landmarks.

DUBLIN C3
From world-class museums and entertainment, superb dining and top-grade hotels, the Irish capital has all the baubles of a major international metropolis. And it's the home of Guinness.

ISLE OF SKYE C2
With jagged mountains, velvet moors and towering sea cliffs, Skye's scenery never fails to impress. And for those days when the mist comes in, there are plenty of castles to explore and cosy pubs to enjoy.

BATH C3
The stunning Georgian architecture of grand town houses and sweeping crescents (not to mention Roman remains, a beautiful cathedral and a cutting-edge 21st-century spa) means England's Bath demands your undivided attention.

PARIS C4

CHAMPAGNE D4

NORDIC EUROPE

SOGNEFJORDEN D2
The drama of Norway's fjords is difficult to overstate. Sheer rock walls plunge from high, green meadows into water-filled canyons shadowed by pretty fjord-side villages. Sognefjorden is the largest fjord network.

SKAGEN D2
Sweeping skies, moving sands and duelling seas – this is Denmark's Jutland's peninsula, where gentle fields give way to ghostly dunes, a buried church and the shape-shifting headland of Grenen.

HELSINKI E2
Functional, elegant, outrageous or wacky: the choice is yours. The Finnish city's decidedly nonmainstream chic is best explored by browsing the vast variety of design shops that spatter its centre.

GOTLAND E2
A lazy bike ride around Gotland is one of the most rewarding ways to spend your time in Sweden: circle the island, passing fields of poppies, shady woodlands, historic churches and ancient rune stones.
