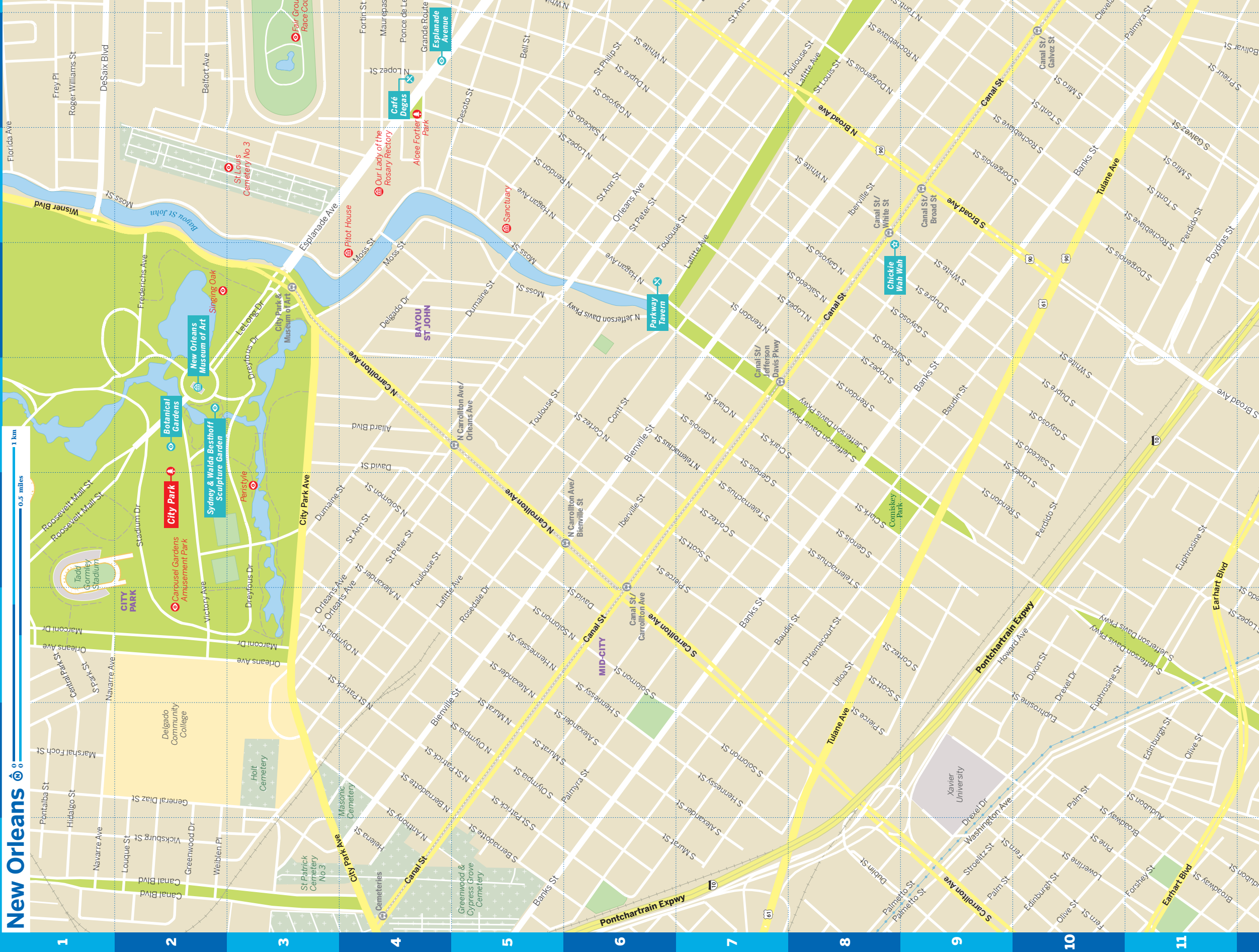

Galler House Museum (O10) Take a stroll through centuries of fascinating French Quarter architecture.



BARGAIN HUNTERS

Preservation Resource Center (M16) Welcoming staff members offer free pamphlets with architecture walking-tour maps for virtually every part of town.

Newcomb Art Gallery (D14) A great spot to soak up art, typically with a local or regional spin – and admission is free!

Sydney & Walda Besthoff Sculpture Garden (E2) This pleasant garden holds 60 pieces of mostly contemporary sculpture, dotted across 5 acres.

Old US Mint (P10) Fantastic, free jazz shows add music to this museum.



SOUTHERN FOOD

Dooky Chase (J8) In the Tremé you'll find the grande dame of African American Creole cookery.

Bayona (M11) Local ingredients and international influences play out in this excellent French Quarter splurge.

Parkway Tavern (F6) Much vaunted neighbourhood institution for a classically executed po'boy.

Clancy's (C20) An Uptown (and upmarket) institution for some of New Orleans' most hallowed dishes.



Chickie Wah Man (F8) Eclectic jazz lineups at this Mid-City institution.



ARCHITECTURE

New Orleans Museum of Art (E2) This imposing edifice is a neoclassical work of art itself.

Esplanade Avenue (H4) Brilliant examples of double gallery homes and Creole mansions.

Ursuline Convent (O10) The grande dame of local French Colonial buildings.

Jackson Square (O11) Bracketed on three sides by some of the best architectural gems in town.



ROMANCE

Café Degas (H4) A rustic, romantic little spot, Degas warms the heart with first-rate French fare.

Botanical Gardens (E2) Stroll hand in hand through this gorgeous collection of plants.

French 75 (M12) High-quality drinks that will make you feel like the star of your own Tennessee Williams play about decadent Southern aristocracy.

Snug Harbor (P9) Classy little establishment for jazz and a hot date.



Passes can be purchased from streetcar conductors, in Walgreens drugstores and from ticket machines at RTA shelters along Canal St. Streetcars run all day, every 20 minutes, and towards every 30 minutes late in the evening.

Bus Service is decent, but no buses run through the French Quarter, so most visitors only use them when venturing uptown or out to City Park. Fares work out to less than \$2.

Bicycle Flat New Orleans is easy to cycle – you can see the entirety of town in 45 minutes. However, heaving potholes, narrow roads and unsafe neighborhoods are some negatives to cycling, and fat tires are a must.

Car The easiest way to access outer neighborhoods is by car. Mid-City. Parking is problematic in the French Quarter and in the CBD.
