10 Top Sights

Rijksmuseum (p90)

The Netherlands' top treasure house bursts with Golden Age paintings, blue-and-white Delft pottery and gilded dollhouses. Rembrandt's humongous, gape-worthy Night Watch leads the pack.





Museum het Rembrandthuis (p126)

Step into the Dutch icon's inner sanctum and immerse yourself in his studio, where soft light streams in through the windows, and seashells, animal horns and other exotica weigh down the shelves.
