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# THE ROCKS

Australia's convict history began here with a squalid canvas shanty town on a rocky shore. Its raucous reputation lives on in atmospheric laneways lined with historic buildings, more than a few of them still operating as pubs. There are also some excellent museums. (Circular Quay)


# SYDNEY HARBOUR NATIONAL PARK
