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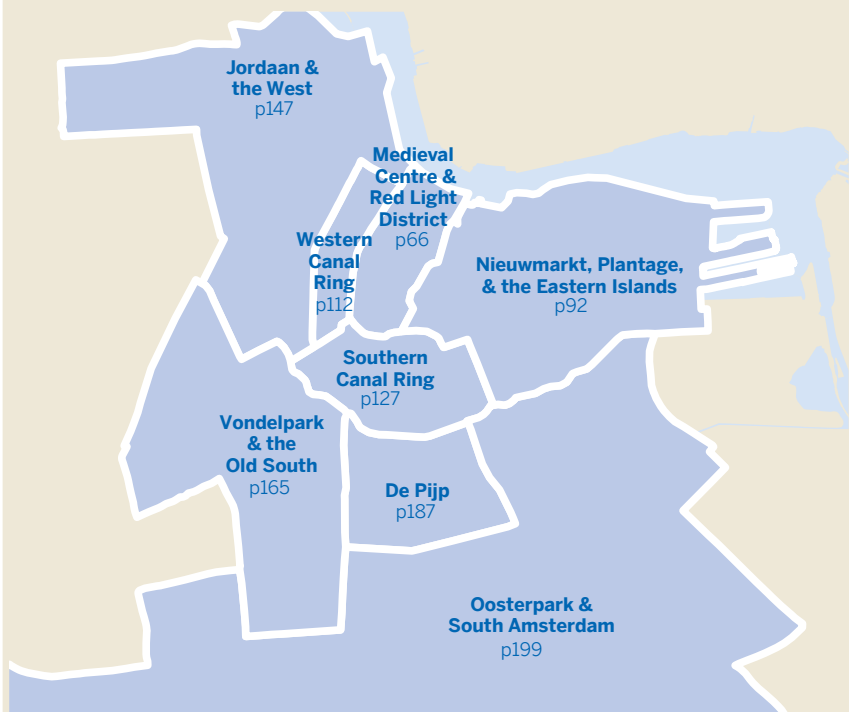

Van Gogh Museum (p170)

1 Housing the world's largest collection by artist Vincent van Gogh, the museum is as much a tour through the driven painter's troubled mind as it is a tour through his body of work. More than 200 canvases are on display, from his dark, potato-filled early career in the Netherlands through to his later years in sunny France, where he produced his best-known work with its characteristic giddy colour. Paintings by contemporaries Gauguin, Toulouse-Lautrec, Monet and Bernard round out the retrospective.

📍 **Vondelpark & the Old South**

Brown Cafés (p49)

2 For the quintessential bite of Amsterdam, pull up a stool in one of the city's famed brown cafés (traditional Dutch pubs). The true specimen has been in business a while and gets its name from centuries' worth of smoke stains on the walls. Brown cafés have candle-topped tables, sandy wooden floors and sometimes a house cat that sidles up for a scratch. Most importantly, brown cafés induce a cosy vibe that prompts friends to linger and chat for hours over drinks – the same enchantment the cafés have cast for 300 years. BELOW: HOPPE (P81)

Rijksmuseum (p167)

3 The Netherlands' top treasure house does not disappoint. The crowds huddle around Rembrandt's humongous *Night Watch* and Vermeer's *Kitchen Maid* in the Gallery of Honour, but that just means the remaining 1.5km of rooms are free for browsing antique ship models, savage-looking swords, crystal goblets and magic lanterns. You could spend days gazing at the beautiful and curious collections tucked into the nooks and crannies. What's more, free sculpture-studded gardens surround the monumental building.

📍 **Vondelpark & the Old South**

Jordaan (p147)

4 If Amsterdam's neighbourhoods held a 'best personality' contest, the Jordaan (once the workers quarter) would win. Its intimacy is contagious, with modest old homes, offbeat galleries and vintage shops peppering a grid of tiny lanes. This is the place for jovial bar singalongs and beery brown *cafés*, the neighbourhood where you could spend a week wandering the narrow streets and still not discover all the hidden courtyards and tucked-away eateries. By now you know the Dutch propensity for *gezelligheid* (conviviality); the Jordaan is a font of it.

📍 **Jordaan & the West**

Vondelpark (p173)

5 On a sunny day it seems the whole city converges on this sprawling equivalent of New York City's Central Park. Couples kiss on the grass, friends cradle beers at the outdoor cafes, while others trade songs on beat-up guitars. Street performers work the crowds and kids rush the playgrounds. It's all very democratic, and sublime for people watching. The English-style layout offers an abundance of ponds, lawns, thickets and winding footpaths that encourage visitors to get out and explore the free-wheeling scene.

📍 **Vondelpark & the Old South**

Outdoor Markets (p59)

6 Amsterdam is market-mad, and its streets hold spreads from silks and coins to organic cheeses and bike locks. The Albert Cuypmarkt is king of the lot. Here Surinamese and Indonesian immigrants mix with locals at stalls hawking rice cookers, spices and Dutch snacks, such as sweet *stroopwafels* (syrup-filled waffles). Flowers fill the Bloemenmarkt, while porcelain teapots and other bric-a-brac tempt at Waterlooplein Flea Market. The Oudemanhuis Book Market has been selling tomes for a few centuries. Then there's the antiques market, farmers market, art market... BELOW: BLOEMENMARKT (P129)

Shopping

King's Day (p23)

7 For decades it was Queen's Day, but there's a new monarch in the house. So now it's King's Day (Koningsdag), celebrated on King Willem-Alexander's birthday of April 27 (unless it falls on a Sunday, in which case it's celebrated the day before). Whatever the name, whatever the date, it's really just an excuse for a gigantic drinking fest and for everyone to wear ridiculous orange outfits, the country's national colour. There's also a free market citywide (where anyone can sell anything) and rollicking free concerts.

Canal Trips (p34)

8 Amsterdam has more canals than Venice and getting on the water is one of the best ways to feel the pulse of the city. You could catch the vibe by sitting canal-side and watching boats glide by: myriad *cafés* seem purpose-built for this sport. Or you could stroll alongside the canals and check out some of the city's 2500 houseboats. Better yet, hop on a tour boat and cruise the curved passages. From this angle, you'll understand why Unesco named the city's waterways a World Heritage Site.

Anne Frank Huis (p114)

9 Seeing Anne Frank's melancholy bedroom and her actual diary, sitting alone in its glass case, is a powerful experience that draws a million visitors annually. Step behind the bookcase that swings open to reveal the 'Secret Annexe' and go up the steep stairs into the living quarters. It was in this dark and airless space that the Franks observed complete silence during the day, outgrew their clothes, pasted photos of Hollywood stars on the walls and read Dickens, before being mysteriously betrayed.

Cycling (p29)

10 There are more bicycles in Amsterdam than cars. Everyone rides: young, old, club-goers in high heels, cops on duty, bankers in suits with ties flapping in the breeze. Pedal power is what moves the masses to work, to shop and to socialise at the cafés. Renting a bike not only puts you shoulder to shoulder with locals, it gives you easy access to the city's outer neighbourhoods and their cool architecture and museums, as well as the windmill-dotted countryside and its time-warped villages.
