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Top Itineraries

Day One

La Rambla & Barri Gòtic (p66)

 On day one spend the morning exploring the narrow medieval lanes of the Barri Gòtic. Have a peak inside **La Catedral** – not missing its geese-filled cloister – and stroll through the picturesque squares of **Plaça de Sant Josep Oriol** and **Plaça Reial**. Discover Barcelona's ancient roots in the fascinating **Museu d'Història de Barcelona**. Before lunch have a wander down La Rambla to take in the passing people parade.

La Ribera (p101)

 In the afternoon, wander over to La Ribera, which is packed with architectural treasures. Take a look inside the majestic **Església de Santa Maria del Mar**. At the **Museu Picasso**, beautifully set inside conjoined medieval mansions, you can spend a few hours taking in the early works of one of the great artists of the 20th century.



Dinner For a seafood feast, head to unsigned El Passadís del Pep (p110).

La Ribera (p101)

 Before having a late dinner (as is the custom in Spain), catch a show inside the **Palau de la Música Catalana**, one of the great Modernista masterpieces of Barcelona. Afterwards end the night with drinks at **El Xampanyet**.

Day Two

L'Eixample (p132)

 On day two start with a morning visit to **La Sagrada Família**, Gaudi's wondrous work in progress. It's worth paying a little extra for a guided tour (or audioguide) for a deeper understanding of Barcelona's most famous sight.



Lunch Tapaç 24 (p145) offers gourmet tapas by celebrated chef Carles Abellán.

L'Eixample (p132)

 After lunch, explore more of the great Modernista buildings by taking a stroll down L'Eixample's **Passeig de Gràcia**. Have a look at the three most famous buildings that make up **La Manzana de la Discòrdia**. Then visit one of Gaudi's house museums on the street – either **Casa Batlló** or **La Pedrera** further up the avenue.

L'Eixample (p132)

 When it comes to cuisine, L'Eixample has Barcelona's biggest selection of award-winning restaurants. For an unrivalled dining experience, book a table at Jordi Vilà's much heralded **Alkímia**, where you can feast on inventive Catalan cuisine matched by first-rate Spanish wines. Afterwards, have a drink at the classy **Les Gens Que J'Aime** before moving on to the big beats at **City Hall**.

Day Three

Barceloneta & the Waterfront (p118)



On your third day in Barcelona it's time to take in the lovely Mediterranean. Start the morning with a jog or a bike ride along the waterfront. Go from Barceloneta to Parc del Forum; beach-facing restaurants and cafes provide refreshment along the way.

Barceloneta & the Waterfront (p118)



For lunch, make your way back to Barceloneta for a seafood feast. The options are bountiful, but for dining with a view, head to **Can Majó** and grab an outdoor table. Afterwards, stroll over to the **Museu d'Història de Catalunya** and peel back the centuries on an interactive journey into Catalan history.

Barceloneta & the Waterfront (p118)



In the evening there's no need to leave the edge of the sea. Have sunset drinks at one of the *chiringuitos* (beach bars), then have tapas back in Barceloneta at **Vaso de Oro** – or for something more upscale head to **Torre d'Alta Mar**. End the evening with stunning views over the sea and city from high up in the **W Hotel** at the bar **Eclipse**.

Day Four

Montjuïc (p181)



Start the day with a scenic cable car ride up to Montjuïc, followed by a stroll past flower and sculpture gardens to the Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya. Take in the magnificent Romanesque frescos, vivid Gothic paintings and works by 17th-century Spanish masters.



Lunch O'Gràcia! (p164) is a charming neighbourhood spot for Catalan fare.

Gràcia (p158)



After getting a taste of Montjuïc, hop on the metro up to Gràcia and wander through its enchanting village-like streets. Cafes, bookshops and vintage shops all make for some worthwhile exploring. The bars surrounding its plazas come to life around sundown.



Dinner La Vinateria del Call (p79) is set in El Call's magical medieval streets.

Camp Nou, Pedralbes and La Zona Alta (p169)



In the evening, catch a football match at **Camp Nou**, the home of the top-ranked FC Barcelona. Amid the roar of the crowds, prepare for a serious adrenalin rush, especially if Barça is playing arch-rivals Real Madrid. If you're still going after the match, end the night over in Barri Gòtic, exploring the vibrant night-life around Plaça Reial and along the narrow streets near Plaça George Orwell.

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
