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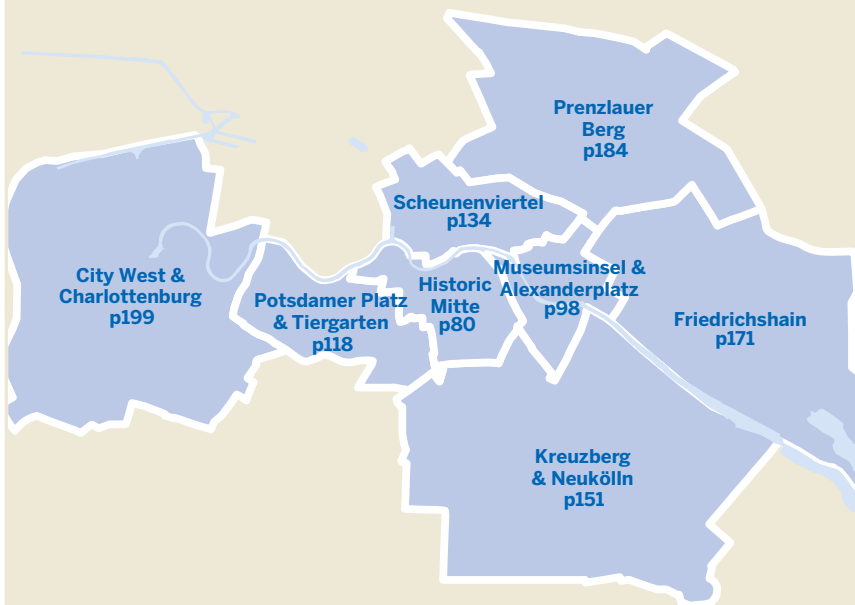

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Top Itineraries

Day One

Historic Mitte (p80)



One day in Berlin? Follow this whirlwind itinerary to take in all the key sights. Book ahead for an early lift ride up to the dome of the **Reichstag**, then snap a picture of the **Brandenburg Gate** before exploring the maze of the **Holocaust Memorial** and admiring the contemporary architecture of **Potsdamer Platz**. View the **Berlin Wall remnants**, then head to **Checkpoint Charlie** to ponder the full extent of the Cold War madness.



Lunch Renew your energies at Augustiner am Gendarmenmarkt (p94).

Historic Mitte (p80)



After lunch, soak up the glory of **Gendarmenmarkt**, drop by **Fassbender & Rausch** for a chocolate treat and get a dose of retail therapy at the **Friedrichstadtpassagen**. Follow Unter den Linden east to **Museumsinsel** and spend at least an hour marvelling at the antiquities in the **Pergamonmuseum**. Beer-o'clock! Head over to **Strandbar Mitte** in the Scheunenviertel.

Scheunenviertel (p134)



After dinner, stroll over to the all-ages **Clärchens Ballhaus** for a spin on the dance floor or process the day's impressions over night-cap drinks at **Butcher's** or wine at **Maxim**.

Day Two

Prenzlauer Berg (p184)



Spend a couple of hours coming to grips with what life in Berlin was like when the Wall still stood by exploring the **Gedenkstätte Berliner Mauer**. Take a quick spin around **Mauerpark**, then grab a coffee at **Bonanza Coffee Heroes** and poke around the boutiques on Kastanienallee.

Museumsinsel & Alexanderplatz (p98)



Start the afternoon by budgeting at least an hour for your audience with Queen Nefertiti and other treasures at the stunning **Neues Museum**, then relax while letting the sights drift by on a one-hour **river cruise** around Museumsinsel. Pop into the nearby **Humboldt-Box** to find out about the giant construction site next to the museums (hint: it's the reconstruction of the Prussian royal city palace) and enjoy the views over a coffee or cocktail from the top-floor cafe.

Kreuzberg & Neukölln (p151)



After dinner, find your favourite libation station along Schlesische Strasse, or shake your booty at **Chalet** or the hipster waterfront **Club der Visionäre**.

Day Three

City West & Charlottenburg (p199)



Day three starts at **Schloss Charlottenburg**, where the Neuer Flügel (New Wing) and the palace garden are essential stops. Take the bus to Zoologischer Garten and meditate upon the futility of war at the **Kaiser-Wilhelm-Gedächtniskirche**, then – assuming it's not Sunday – satisfy your shopping cravings along **Kurfürstendamm** and its side streets. Keep your wallet handy and drop by shopping malls **Bikini Berlin** and **KaDeWe**.

Spend an hour or two at the amazing Daniel Libeskind-designed **Jüdisches Museum**, then go local on a stroll down Bergmannstrasse, building in a cafe stop for a pick-me-up. Potsdam (p216)



There's plenty more to do in Berlin proper, but we recommend you spend the better part of the day exploring the parks and royal palaces in Potsdam, a mere 40-minute S-Bahn ride away. Buy online tickets for your favourite time slot to see **Schloss Sanssouci**, a rococo jewel of a palace. Afterwards, explore the surrounding park and its many smaller palaces at leisure. The **Chinesisches Haus** is a must-see.
