
Why Go?



- 2 Poke around mining ghost towns in **Death Valley National Park** (p686)

- 4 Hunt rare elephant trees and scramble around the wind caves of vast Anza-Borrego Desert State Park (p674)
- 5 Hide out at Hole-in-the-Wall (p684) in the forgotten Mojave National Preserve
- 6 Lose yourself (but hopefully not your money) on the Las Vegas Strip (p696)
- 7 Revel in the mythology of the Mother Road at the California Route 66 Museum (p681) in Victorville
- 3 Feel fabulous stretched out next to the kidney-shaped pool in a **Mid-Century Modern boutique hotel** (p659) in Palm Springs
