Explore the jungles, mangroves, waterfalls, islands and beaches of the southern Cardamom Mountains

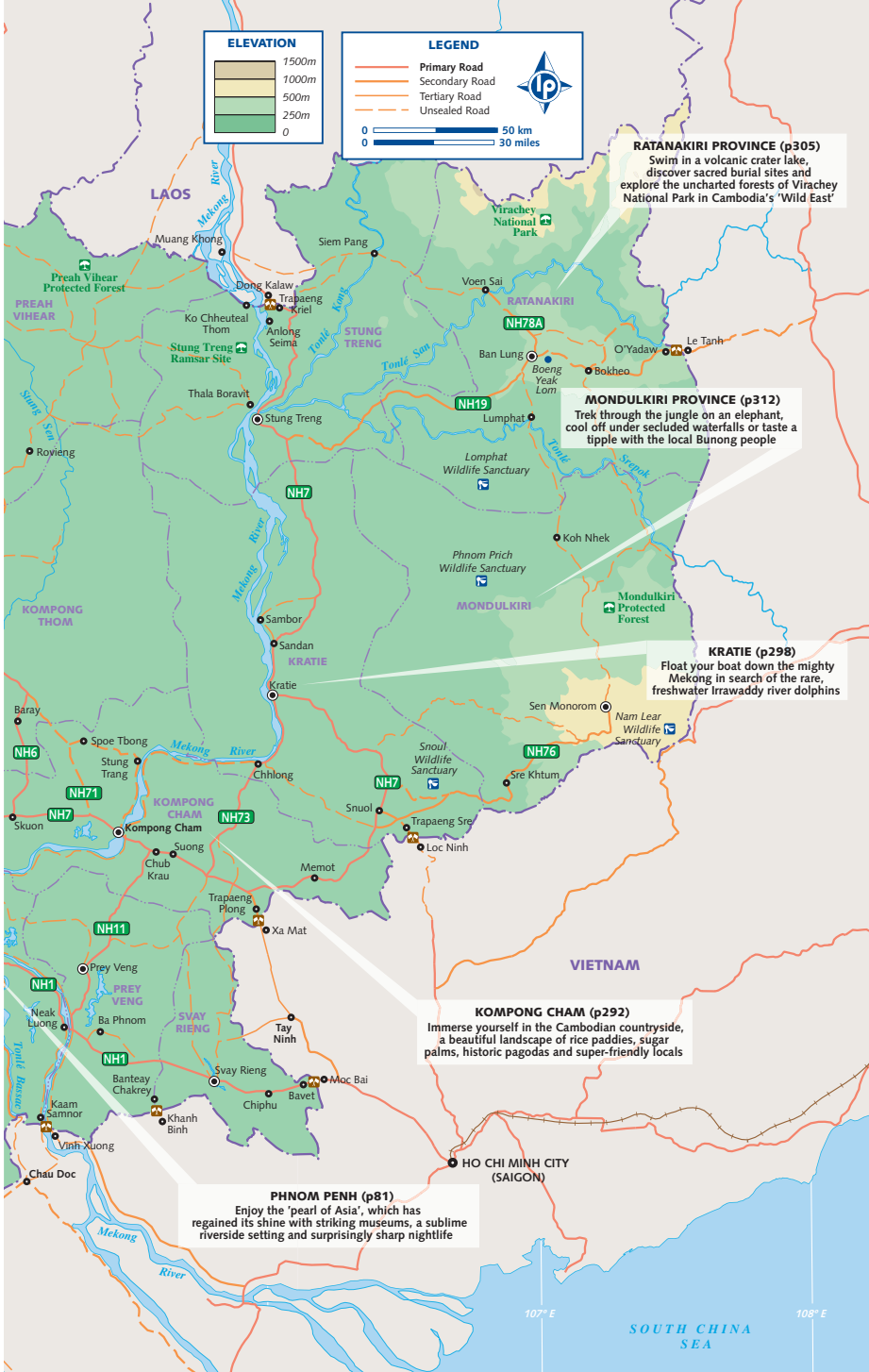
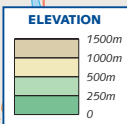
BOKOR NATIONAL PARK (p229)
