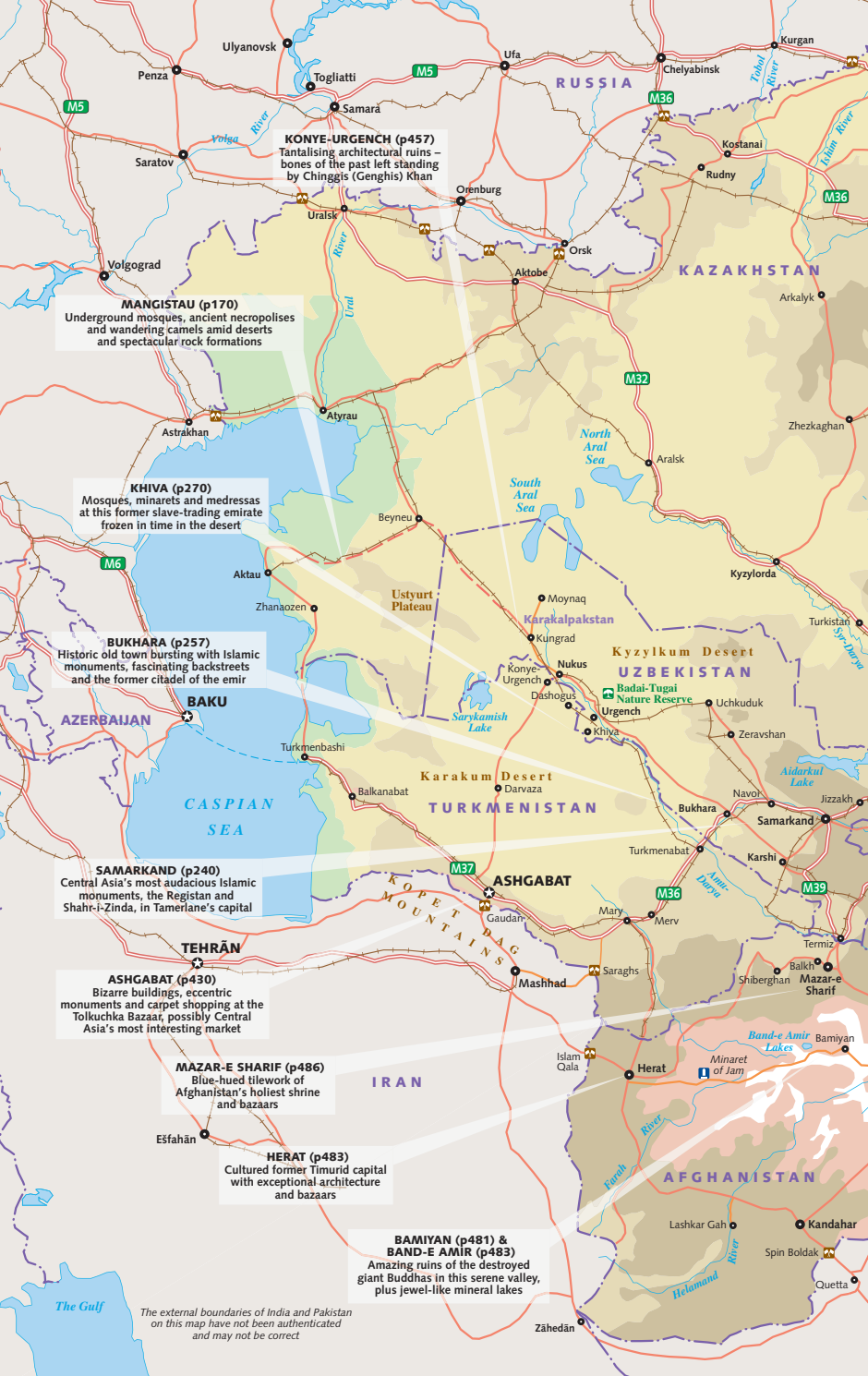

Cultured former Timurid capital with exceptional architecture and bazaars

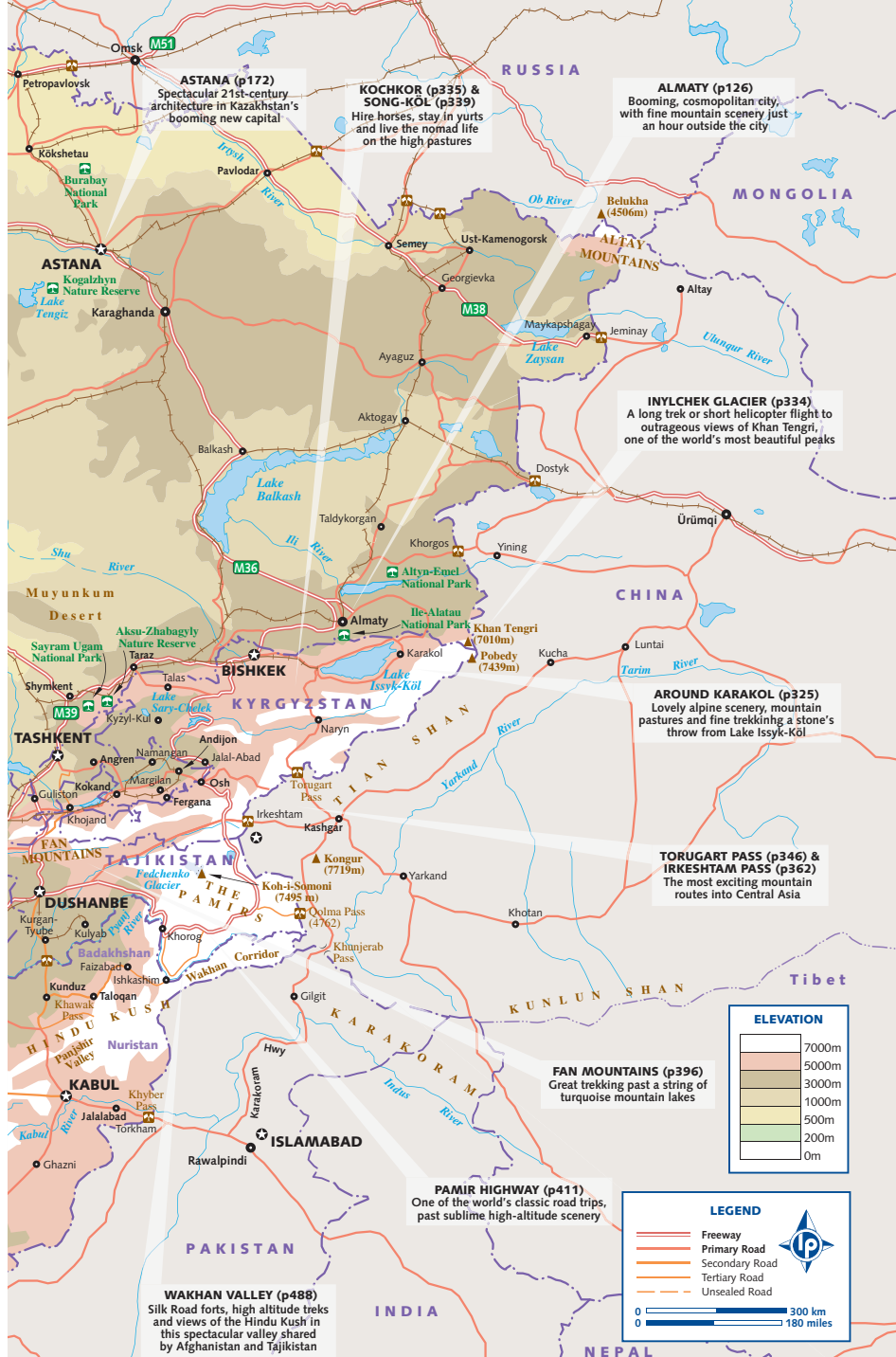
