## Why Go?


Southwest Colombia, often overlooked by visitors, is one of the most diverse and interesting regions in the country. It is Andean and African, modern and pre-Columbian – a land of contrasts that stimulates the senses at every opportunity.

Here you will find the best archaeological sites in the country and some of its finest colonial architecture. It's a place of immense biodiversity where you can pass through desert, jungle and *páramo* (high-mountain plain) ecosystems in just one day. Nature lovers will find active volcanoes, thermal springs and spectacular mountain ranges all easily accessible from thriving metropolitan centers with fashionable accommodations.

Cali is the biggest city in the region and is famous for its vibrant salsa clubs, but it also has plenty to offer non-dancers including charming old neighborhoods, fine restaurants and hip bars all served up with a big portion of *caleño* attitude.

**Sep** Head to Cali's Festival Mundial de Salsa and Popayán's Congreso Nacional Gastronómico.

**Jul-Sep** Local thermal winds pack an extra punch for the best kitesurfing on Lago Calima.

**Dec & Jan** Clear skies make for pleasant hiking in Parque Nacional Natural (PNN) Puracé.
