Welcome to Paris

France's romanticised capital seduces every moment of the year. Whether you're here in the springtime, the autumn, the winter (when it drizzles) or the summer (when it sizzles!), Paris' cache of artistic treasures, chic fashion sense, exquisite cuisine and majestic monuments captivate locals and visitors alike.

No matter the season, Paris has a timeless familiarity. The Eiffel Tower's wroughtiron spire, the Arc de Triomphe standing sentinel above Paris' most glamorous avenue, the Champs-Élysées, the gargoyled Notre Dame cathedral and the art nouveau cafes spilling onto wicker-chair-lined terraces are indelibly etched in the minds of anyone who's visited the city – and in the imaginations of anyone who hasn't.

Paris' cuisine (the French word for 'kitchen') is renowned. From cosy neighbour-hood bistros to triple-Michelin-starred temples of gastronomy, you'll find every establishment prides itself on exquisite preparation and presentation of quality produce, invariably served with wine. forte. Paris remains at the forefront of international fashion trends, and browsing designer boutiques and flagship haute couture houses is a quintessential part of any visit. You'll also find uberhip concept stores and resplendent art nouveau department stores, along with a trove of vintage shops, flea markets, atmospheric bookshops, adorable children's wear, art and antique dealers, and, of course, gourmet food and wine shops galore.

Paris is one of the great art repositories of the world. In addition to big hitting museums including the world's largest, the Louvre, there are scores of smaller museums housing collections of every imaginable genre – tangible reminders of the city's illustrious artistic legacy, which endures to this day.
