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## Why Go?


The forests in Karelia are...deeper somehow. Visit Karelia and you'll experience the truth of this wistful statement. If you're looking for wilderness, powerful history and perhaps even the Finnish soul, your search starts here.

Koli National Park is close to every Finnish heart, but the whole region is a blessing for nature lovers. Hiking routes thread through the area, Ruunaa is renowned for rafting, lovely Lake Pielinen is a kayaker's dream, and there's great winter skiing. Bears, wolverines and even wolves roam freely across the Russian frontier and animal hides allow visitors a close encounter.


Karelia is a region of contradictions, with its culture, language, religion, cuisine and music all heavily influenced by its eastern neighbour. The fierce battles of WWII are raw and close; you can feel the weight of history in Lappeenranta, pining for its sister cities lost to Russia, while battle-scarred Joensuu has reinvented itself as a lively young university town.

Mid-Apr The bear-watching season begins, when brown bears wake from their winter sleep. Jul Folk in Joensuu have a blast at the international llosaari Rock Festival. Dec Finland's most accessible ski resort at Koli National Park opens for business.
