## Why Go?


Beautiful Turku reclines along its grassy-banked river, flowing from Gothic cathedral to medieval castle. This seafaring city was once the capital of Finland, and its fascinating history is matched by an equally attractive present. Turku challenges Helsinki's cultural cred with excellent galleries, museums and restaurants, while rocking music festivals electrify the summer air. Historic Naantali, the home of Muumimaailma (Moominworld), makes a perfect side trip.

The south-coast towns, stretching to either side of Helsinki, share Turku's maritime heritage. Kotka's port remains a tough worker, while Hamina's fortress-town glory days make it a veteran with war stories to tell. Hanko, with its venerable villas and vibrant regatta, is a silver fox with immense powers of charm.

And everywhere there are islands, providing great yachting challenges or sea-salt retreats. The 20,000-strong Turku archipelago creates a sea-full of stepping stones across to Åland and Sweden.

**Mar** Turku's venerable jazz festival keeps the winter blues at bay.

**Jul** Boats race in the Hanko Regatta, famous for its carnival atmosphere.

**Aug** Marching and military music at the weeklong Hamina Tattoo.
