Kentucky is stitched together with bluegrass pastures and jutting seams of limestone. Lonely two-lane roads link distilleries on the Bourbon Trail, and skirt the breeding grounds of million-dollar thoroughbreds in the countryside surrounding Lexington and Louisville.

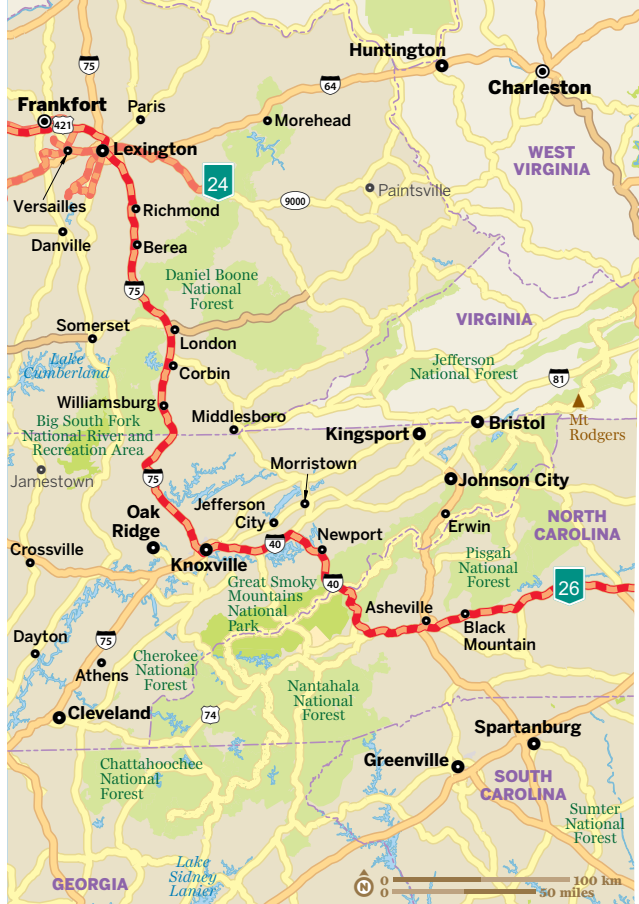
