Variety is the watchword in Bavaria and Baden-Württemberg (the two states that make up Germany's south); driving this chapter's routes could have you taking a Zeppelin ride above Lake Constance, ascending Germany's highest mountain by train and passing through thickly wooded landscapes of the Bavarian Forest, all in a matter of days.

But all the routes have something in common – the affluent south is infused with that feeling of *Gemütlichkeit*, a state of cosiness and good cheer you'll discover in every traditional tavern and inn from Franconia to the Alps.
