## Why Go?


Log cabins? Pine forests? Mountains? Whatever happened to the steppes and the herds of camels? If it weren't for the gers and motorbike riders in traditional Mongolian dress, you could confuse this lush and rugged land with Switzerland.

Selenge, Bulgan and Khövsgöl aimags actually have more in common with Siberia than the rest of Mongolia, with long, cold winters and wildflower-dotted summers. This is the adventure playground of Mongolia, with superb opportunities for horse riding, hiking, mountain biking, kayaking and boating along the glorious shores of Lake Khövsgöl.

The inhospitable border area between Russia and Mongolia is home to the Tsaatan reindeer herders doing their best to preserve their traditional lifestyle. And if you're interested in spiritual practices, shamanism is once again alive and well in northern Mongolia after decades of suppression under communism, as is Buddhism in the splendid Amarbayasgalant monastery.

## When to Go

### Mörön



**Jul** Warm and dry, but also the tourist crunch. Catch naadam in Khatgal or Renchinlhumbe.

**Late Aug–Sep** Trek in the taiga with fewer bugs, and see the leaves change colour.

**Late Feb** Skiing, skating and ice fishing at the Khatgal Ice Festival.

Northern Mongolia Highlights

- ❶ Drop a fishing line into **Khövsgöl Nuur** (p147), and while away an afternoon by Mongolia's loveliest alpine lake.
  - ❷ Visit Tsaaitan reindeer herders from the remote **Darkhad Depression** (p155)
  - ❸ Wander the grounds of **Amarbayasgalant Khid**

(p136), the architectural highlight of the country.

4 Visit the bow-and-arrow-making workshop **Dulaankhaan** (p133), on the last in Mongolia.

- 5 Journey to **Chandman-Öndör** (p154), a little-visited region of fish-filled streams, hot springs and sacred caves.
  - 6 Study the curious deer stone carvings at **Uushigin**
  - 7 Enjoy the excellent dining in **Erdene** (p138) or peer into the depths of the city's copper mine.
  - 8 Over (p146), one of the best examples of ancient rock art in Mongolia.
