





# Queenstown & the South Trips

**DISCOVER THE LANDSCAPES THAT  
LURE IN TRAVELLERS FROM THE WORLD  
OVER** – the mountains, fiords, lakes and  
coastlines of New Zealand's deep south.

The centre of the action is NZ's year-round adventure capital, Queenstown, with more direct flights making it an increasingly popular starting point for driving tours. It's a striking gateway to many of NZ's pin-up places, from the golden-hued schist country of Central Otago, to the deep green, ancient forests of Stewart Island. In between is Fiordland National Park – one of the world's great remaining wildernesses and home to Milford Sound – and coastal highway so spectacular yet so quiet you can only be at the very edge of civilisation.
