
The area south of Manila is home to a clutch of interesting military history sights and some of the most dramatic landscapes you'll find anywhere. Volcanoes are the speciality, with some impressive seascapes thrown in.

Head north and you'll run square into the most notorious volcano of them all, Mt Pinatubo, in the underrated Zambales Mountains. It overlooks the twin ex-military bases of Subic and Clark, now struggling to become tourism hubs.

Unfortunately, getting out of Manila can take the bulk of the morning in rush hour traffic. With the obvious exception of tailor-made day trip Corregidor, most highlights are not really day-trip material by public transport. This is one place you might consider renting a car.
