
The area south of Manila is home to a clutch of interesting military history sights and some of the most dramatic landscapes you'll find anywhere. Volcanoes are the specialty, with some impressive sea- and townscapes thrown in.

Head north and you'll run square into the most notorious volcano of them all, Mt Pinatubo, in the underrated Zambales Mountains. It overlooks the twin ex-military bases of Subic and Clark, now struggling to become tourism hubs.

Though it's possible to visit these places as day trips, getting out of Manila can take the bulk of the morning, so it's better to do overnight stays.

## When to Go

**Dec–Feb** The coolest months are particularly welcome.

**May** Local peaks become places of refuge in the height of the hot season.

**Aug–Oct** Some surf on the Zambales Coast within range of Subic.
