Top Itineraries

Day One

Ipanema & Leblon (p56)

 Spend the first day soaking up the rays on **Ipanema beach**. Be sure to hydrate with *maté* (cold sweetened tea) and *água de côco* (coconut juice), sample a few beach snacks (or a sandwich at **Uruguai**) and take a scenic stroll down to Leblon.



Lunch Market (p63) serves delectable fare on a well-concealed patio.

Ipanema & Leblon (p56)

 In the afternoon, have a wander through the streets of Ipanema, doing some window-shopping on Rua Garcia d'Ávila, stopping for ice cream at **Vero**, and getting a coffee fix at **Cafeína**. Later, stroll over to **Ponta do Arpoador**, and watch the sunset behind Dois Irmãos.

Ipanema & Leblon (p56)

 Catch a concert at **Studio RJ**, a great new space for jazz, rock and samba. Afterwards, head downstairs to **Bar Astor**, which has a great cocktail menu. If you're not ready to call it a night, go to **Barzin**, a festive bar and live-music venue that stays open until 3am.

Day Two

Flamengo & Around (p108)

 Starting off in Cosme Velho, take the cog train up Corcovado to admire the view beneath the open-armed **Cristo Redentor**. Nearby, visit the **Museu International de Arte Naif do Brasil**, which is full of colorful folk art from Brazil and beyond.



Lunch Have a leisurely lunch at Bar do Mineiro (p138), a Santa Teresa classic.

Santa Teresa & Lapa (p133)

 Afterwards, wander through Santa Teresa, Rio's most atmospheric neighborhood. Browse for handicrafts at **La Vereda**, admire the views from the **Parque das Ruínas** and check out the eclectic art collection and lush gardens of **Museu Chácara do Céu**. Have a pick-me-up in **Cafecito**.



Dinner Feast on beautiful Amazonian dishes at Espírito Santa (p138).

Santa Teresa & Lapa (p133)

 Take a taxi downhill to Lapa for a late night of samba and caipirinhas. Start the evening taking in the street party around the Arcos da Lapa, before making your way to **Rio Scenarium**, a beautiful antique-filled club where you can join samba-loving crowds on the dance floor – or just watch the evening unfold from an upper balcony.

Day Three

Barra da Tijuca & Western Rio (p151)

 In the morning, go for a hike in **Floresta da Tijuca**, which has rainforest-lined hiking trails, refreshing waterfalls and spectacular views from craggy summits.



Lunch Pay-by-weight Frontera (p89) provides countless temptations.

Copacabana & Leme (p84)

 In the afternoon take in the sun and surf on **Copacabana beach**. If you're feeling active, you can try your hand at stand-up paddle boarding. After a few hours in the sun, stroll to the southern end of the neighborhood, where you can visit the **Forte de Copacabana**. Here you'll find a small museum and several relaxing open-air cafes with memorable views across the sweep of Copacabana beach.



Dinner Enjoy a meal on the sand at one of the beachside kiosks (p89).

Copacabana & Leme (p84)

 After an early dinner, wander over to **Bip Bip**, a hole-in-the-wall bar that hosts some of the best *samba de roda* (informal samba played in a circle) in the Zona Sul. Cap off the evening over drinks with beachfront views at **Horse's Neck**, or for something a little livelier hit the dance floor at **Fosfobox**.

Day Four

Centro & Cinelândia (p117)

 Stroll around Centro for a look at Rio's historic district. Start off in the **Museu Histórico Nacional**, which has excellent exhibits tracing 500-plus years of history. Be sure to peek in some of the city's most impressive colonial churches, including **Igreja São Francisco da Penitência** and the **Igreja de Nossa Senhora do Carmo da Antiga Sé**.



Lunch Enjoy rich seafood dishes and bay views at AlbaMar (p129).

Botafogo & Urca (p97)

 Spend the afternoon down in Urca. Take the cable-car to the top of **Pão de Açúcar**, where Rio spreads before you in a stunning panorama. Afterwards, head over to Botafogo to for drinks and pre-dinner tapas plates at **Oui Oui**.

Gávea, Jardim Botânico & Lagoa (p97)

 After dinner, go for amazing cocktails and even better views at the open-air lakeside setting of **Palaphita Kitch**. If you're still going strong, end the night at **OO (Zero Zero)**, which has a small, fired-up dance floor and top-notch DJs.
