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
Why Go?

Widely regarded as Romania's most traditional region, scattered with gothically steeped wooden churches and villagers' homes fronted by ornately carved gates, Maramureș feels as if you are climbing into a horse-drawn time machine and heading back 100 years. Smaller in scale and softer in contour than neighboring Transylvania, Maramureș' tapestry of pastureland, peopled by colourfully garbed crane-faced peasants, jumps straight from a Brothers Grimm story. Welcome to the heart of folkloric, medieval Romania where the last peasant culture in Europe continues to thrive. But don't wait forever to visit: even here the 21st century is making inroads.

Medieval Maramureș exists in the Mara and Izei Valleys. Eight of its churches, in the villages of Bârsana, Budești, Desești, Ieud, Plopîș, Poienile Izei, Rogoz and Surdești, are on Unesco's list of World Heritage Sites.

When to Go


Baia Mare
