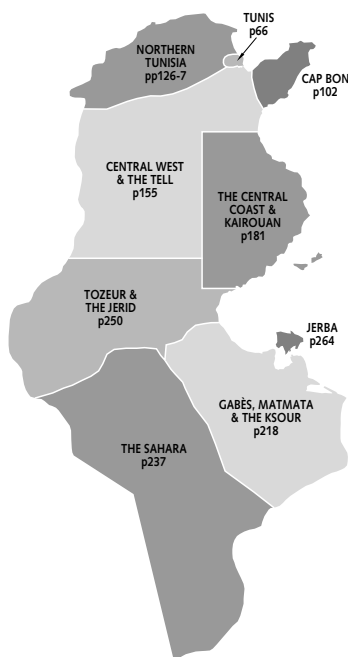


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Regional Map Contents

 Balmey, busy resort, basking by day and sizzling by night

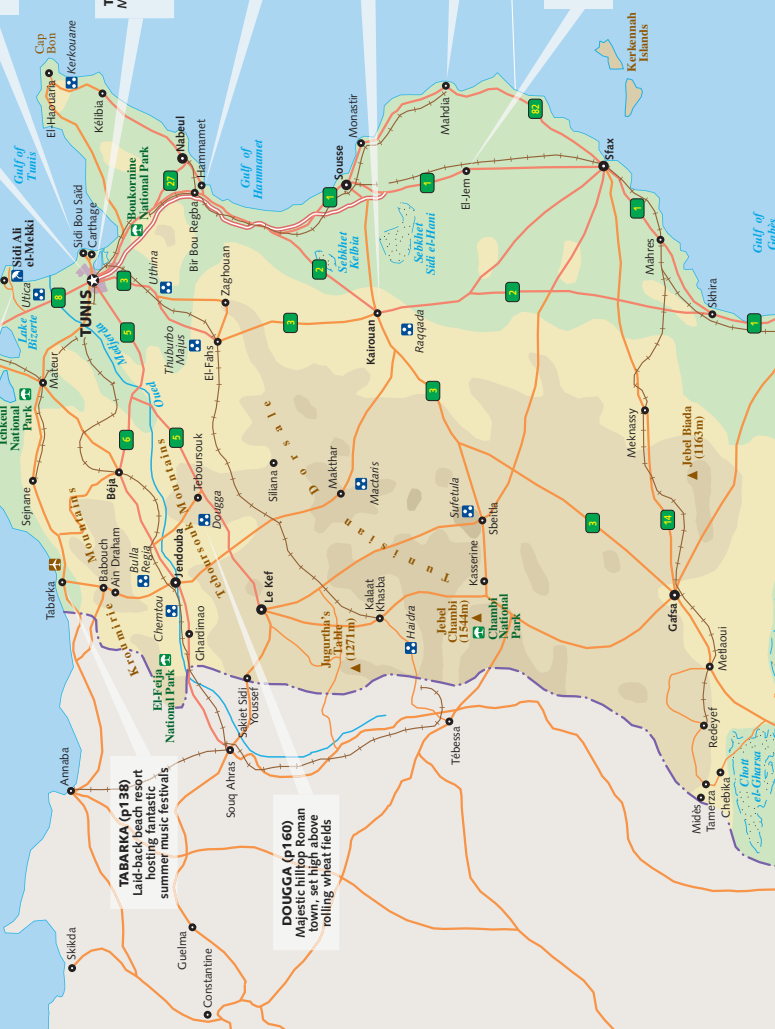
KAIROUAN (p195)

 Awesome colosseum to rival Rome's and a splendid, mosaic-filled museum

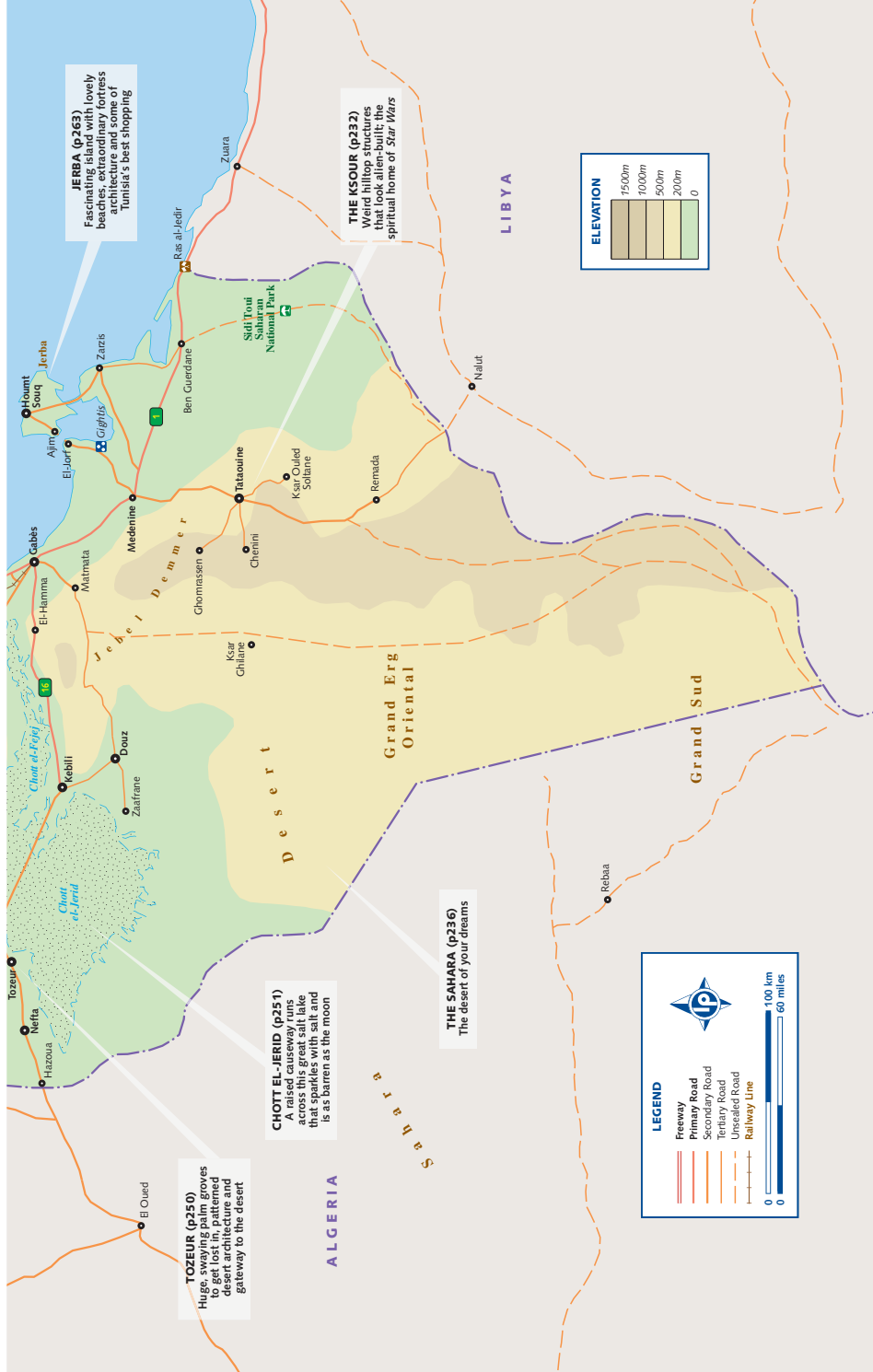
TABARKA (p138)

 Majestic hilltop Roman town, set high above rolling wheat fields



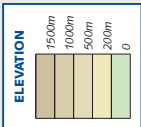
