



Driving Tour: Ruta de las Flores

The Flower Route winds through a series of charming villages, offering a mix of thriving artisan culture, rich coffee and access to waterfalls and natural bathing pools.

Start Sonsonate

Distance 50km

Duration Two days



5 Head on to **Ataco** to check out some brightly colored murals, colonial buildings and a spring-fed pool.

Take a Break: Stop for a cup of joe at the delightful **El Jardín de Celeste**.

4 Continue to El Salvador's second-highest town, **Apaneca**, and hop on a canopy or dirty buggy tour.

6 Finish in the prosperous, provincial capital of **Ahuachapán**, and visit the area's steaming mud pits.

3 Roll on to **Salcoatitán**, with its cobblestone streets and tiny art galleries.

1 Begin your drive or catch the chicken bus in **Sonsonate**, and head directly to Juayúa.
