Dūnhuáng Travel out of town to the incredible Mògão Grottoes and the Singing Sand Dunes and spend the night in Dūnhuáng.

Jiāyùguān Spend a day or two in – Jiāyùguān to visit its splendid desert fort at the western end of the Great Wall. Q 4 hrs to Lánzhōu

> Lánzhōu Lánzhōu has little of interest, but it's the launchpad for a four-hour bus trip to Labrang Monastery in Xiàhé, where you can spend the night. 1 hr to Xī'ān or 9 hrs to Xī'ān

XT'an Come face to face with the Terracotta Warriors before returning to town to walk around its magnificent city wall and dine in the Muslim Quarter. Q 6 hrs to Shànghǎi

Běijīng Spend three days exploring the Forbidden City, the Temple of Heaven and the Great Wall. ▲ 4 hrs to Dunhuáng

> Shànghǎi Shànghǎi's most grandiose sight is the Bund, but the Shànghǎi
> Museum is not to be missed, while the French Concession is the place for boutique shopping and charming bars.
