



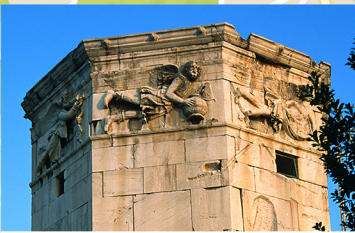
Central Athens

The key ancient sites of Athens make for an action-packed but manageable walk through central Athens. If you only have one day to see the sights, follow this itinerary.

Start Temple of Olympian Zeus

Distance 2.4km

Duration 3½ hours



6 The highlight of the **Roman Agora** is the 1st century BC Tower of the Winds.

7 The **Ancient Agora** also has a top-notch museum in the colonnaded Stoa of Attalos.

5 On a clear day you can see the **Acropolis** miles from the hilltop.



2 **Hadrian's Arch** was erected in AD 132 to mark the boundary between Hardian's monuments and the ancient city.

4 The magnificent **Odeon of Herodes Atticus** built in AD 161 is still in use today.

3 The landmark **Acropolis Museum** displays the precious sculptures from the Acropolis.

1 The striking **Temple of Olympian Zeus** had 104 Corinthian columns of which 15 remain.
