



# Corfu's Old Town

For this walk through Corfu's Old Town, be sure to pack your sun cream and swimming gear – you're going to need them along the way. Start at the south-eastern end of the elegant, French-built Liston arcade.

**Start** Liston

**Distance** 2km

**Duration** Three to four hours

**4** Settle down with a book in the library of the **Corfu Reading Society**.

**7** **Plateia Dimarchio**, easily the Old Town's sweetest square, is lined with cafes and restaurants.

**6** The church housing the **Antivouniotissa Museum** displays some sublime religious icons.

**5** Join locals taking a sea dip at the spot that once housed the **city baths**.



**3** The incredible **Corfu Museum of Asian Art** is one of the finest of its kind in Europe.

**2** Pop into the **Durrell Memorial Gardens**, named after writers (and brothers) Gerald and Lawrence Durrell.
