



Thessaloniki City Walk

Start this city stroll around 9am, as many churches close by noon. Avoid Mondays, when most sites are closed.

Start Eptapyrgion
Distance 4km
Duration 3 hours



5 The burly 7th-century **Church of Agios Dimitrios**, occupying its own square, shelters relics of St Dimitrios.

3 Unesco-listed **Church of Osios David** is a 5th-century gem resplendent with rare frescoes.

1 Thessaloniki's highest and most scenic point is the **Eptapyrgion** a Byzantine fortress turned Turkish prison

2 There are great views from **Kastra**, the easternmost end of the Byzantine Walls.

4 Masterpieces of devotional frescoes blaze from the walls of the intimate Byzantine **Church of Nikolaos Orfanos**.
