Of all the neighborhoods in New York City, the West Village is easily the most walkable, its cobbled corners straying from the signature gridiron that carves up the rest of Manhattan. An afternoon stroll is not to be missed; hidden landmarks and quaint cafes abound.

- **4** For another TV landmark, head to **66 Perry St**, Carrie Bradshaw's apartment in Sex and the City.
- **3** Stop at **Buvette**, a dreamy Francophile wine bar perfect for people-watching with coffee or *vin*.

5 At Christopher Park, visit the **Stonewall National Monument** and Stonewall Inn – where 1969 riots sparked the Gay Rights Movement.
