Lake Titicaca Enjoy two days on South America's largest lake, visiting traditional communities on floating reed islands. 🚗 6 hrs to La Paz

3 La Paz Take in staggering panoramas, vibrant markets and ethnographic museums over two days in Bolivia's sky-high metropolis. ✈ 1 hr to Uyuni

4 Salar de Uyuni Enjoy the surreal scenery of the world's largest salt flats on a two-day tour around Salar de Uyuni. 🚗 9 hrs to San Pedro de Atacama

5 The Atacama Desert Spend two days taking in Atacama's marvels: geysers, Mars-like valleys and pre-Columbian ruins.
