



Vienna's Historic Centre

This walk takes you from the cathedral through the historic centre of Vienna, with highlights from many historical periods.

Start Stephansdom

Distance 3km

Duration 1½ hours



5 Hoher Markt, Vienna's oldest square, is now a busy commercial street; highlights include the **Römer Museum** (www.wienmuseum.at; Hoher Markt 3).

Take a Break... Hit historic **Griechenbeisl** (www.griechenbeisl.at; 01, Fleischmarkt 11; mains €15-28; 11.30am-11.30pm) off the Fleischmarkt.

4 Busy **Fleischmarkt** is the heart of the Greek quarter of Vienna. Climb the stairs to Judengasse, centre of the traditional Jewish quarter.

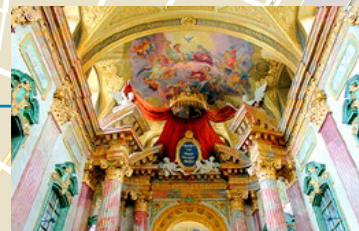
3 Enter **Heiligenkreuzerhof** from the eastern side. During Christmas this lovely courtyard is filled with traditional decorations.

7 On the way along Graben back towards Stephansplatz, pop into **Adolf Loos' Public Toilets** (opposite Graben 22), replete with mahogany-panelled stalls and exquisite tiling.



6 The most impressive church besides Stephansdom, the **Peterskirche** (Petersplatz; ☎7am-8pm Mon-Fri, 9am-9pm Sat & Sun) has a dome painted by JM Rottmayr and a golden altar.

1 Wind through the atmospheric backstreets to **Mozarthaus Vienna**, where the great composer lived for three years.



2 Inside **Jesuitenkirche** (Dr-Ignaz-Seipel-Platz 1; ☎7am-7pm Mon-Sat, 8am-7pm Sun), frescoes create the illusion of a dome, while the **Dominikanerkirche** (Postgasse 4; ☎7am-7pm) is Vienna's finest early baroque church.
