

Syntagma & Plaka to Monastiraki

Monument-packed central Athens is best explored on foot. The main civic hub – Plateia Syntagmatos – merges into the historic neighbourhoods, making for an atmospheric stroll.

Start Plateia Syntagmatos Distance 2.5km **Duration** Three hours

6 Hadrian's Library (adult/child €4/free; (\$\text{98am-3pm}) was once the most luxurious public building in the city, erected by the eponymous emperor around AD 132.

4 The 17th-century Bath House of the Winds (adult/child €2/free; ⊗8am-3pm Wed-Mon), a historic (but nonfunctional) hammam is one of the few remnants of the Ottoman Empire, and the only surviving public bath building.
