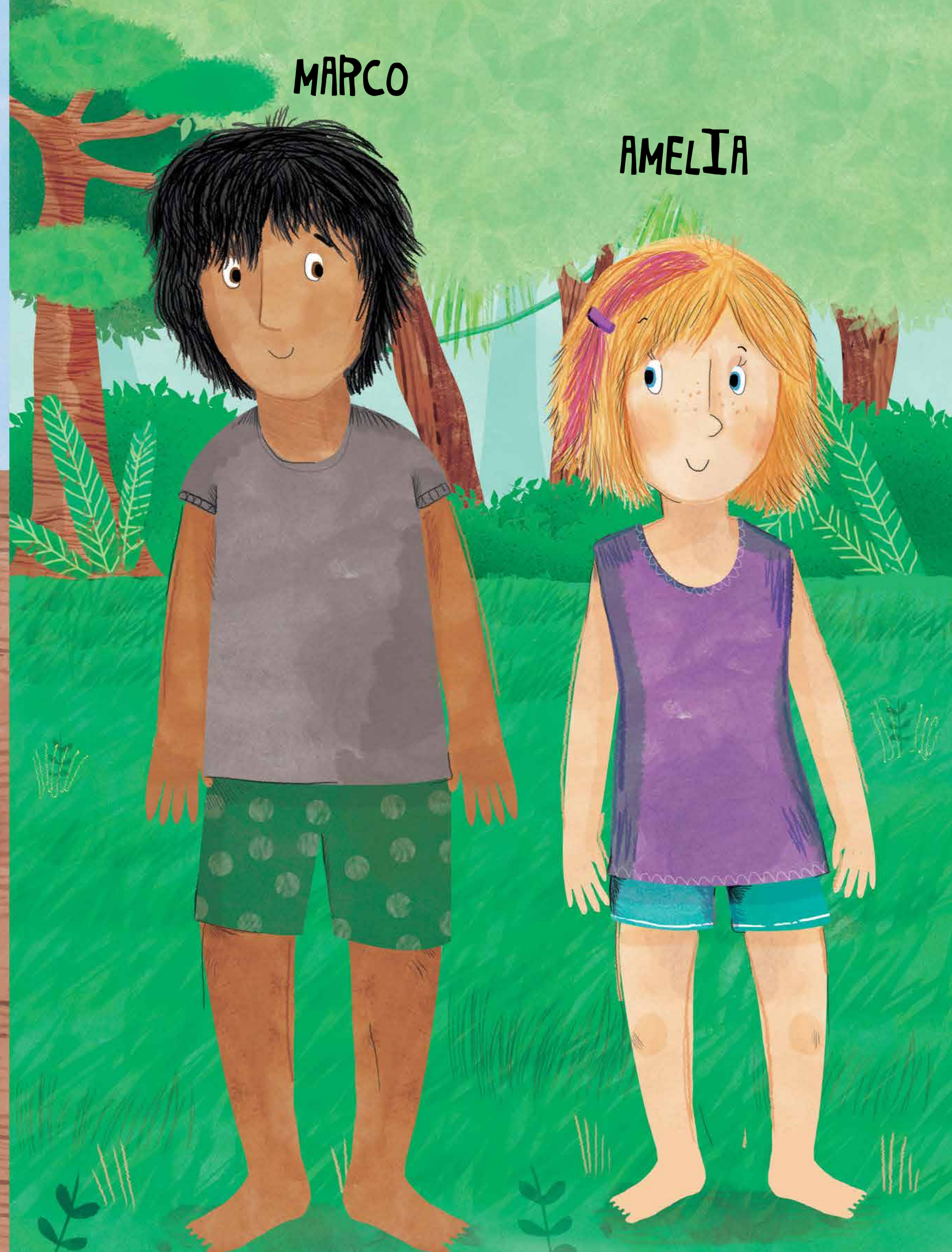

I drink the nectar from flowers.

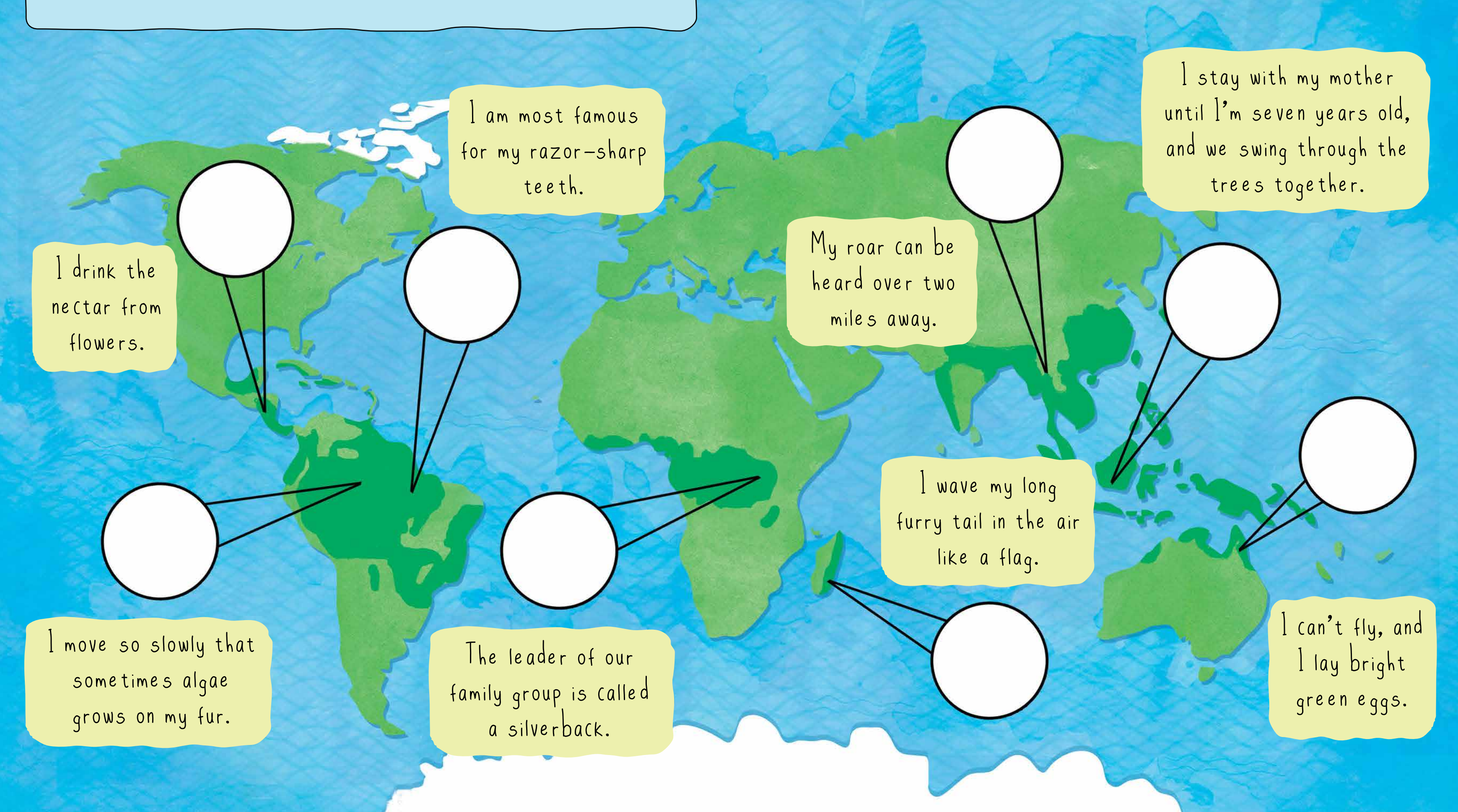
My roar can be heard over two miles away.

A red tomato frog?



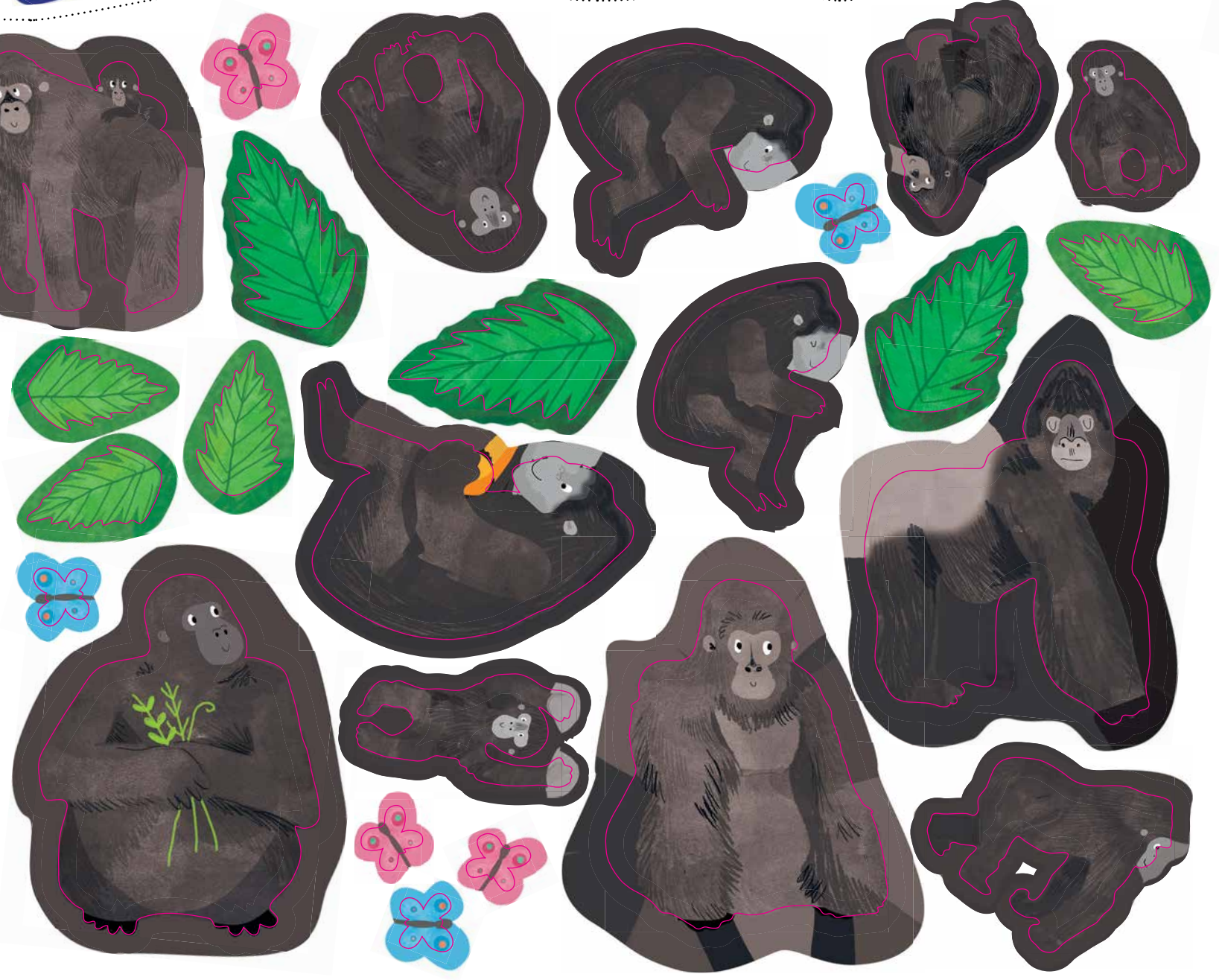

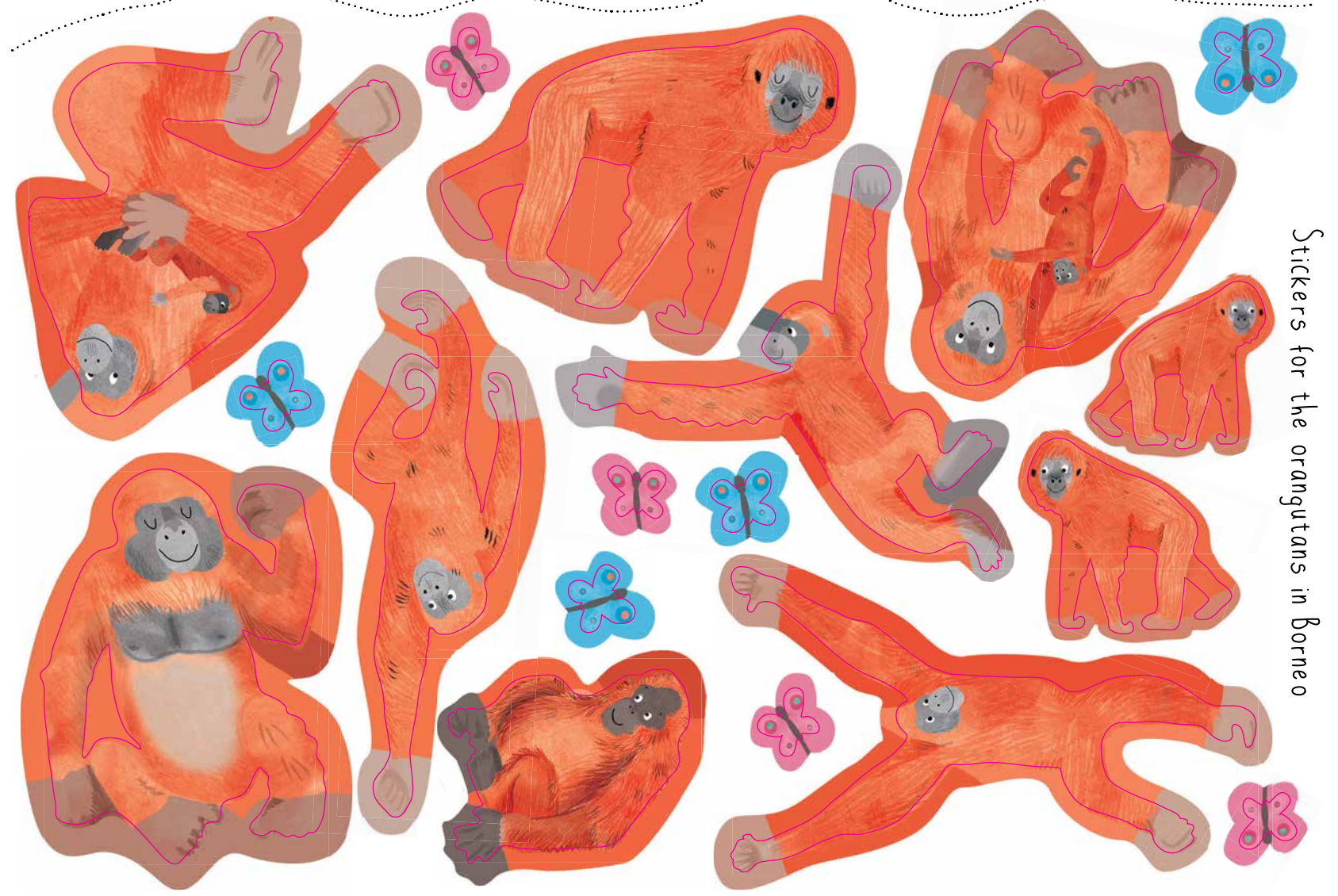
