Great to meet you! Geronimo and I photographed alligators together while we were in the Everglades. Let's go and see what we can find!

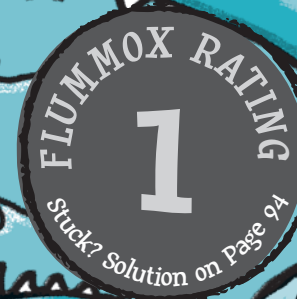

The limestone at the rim of the canyon is around 230 million years old. The layers of rock get steadily older until you reach the bottom, where the schist rock is over two billion years old.

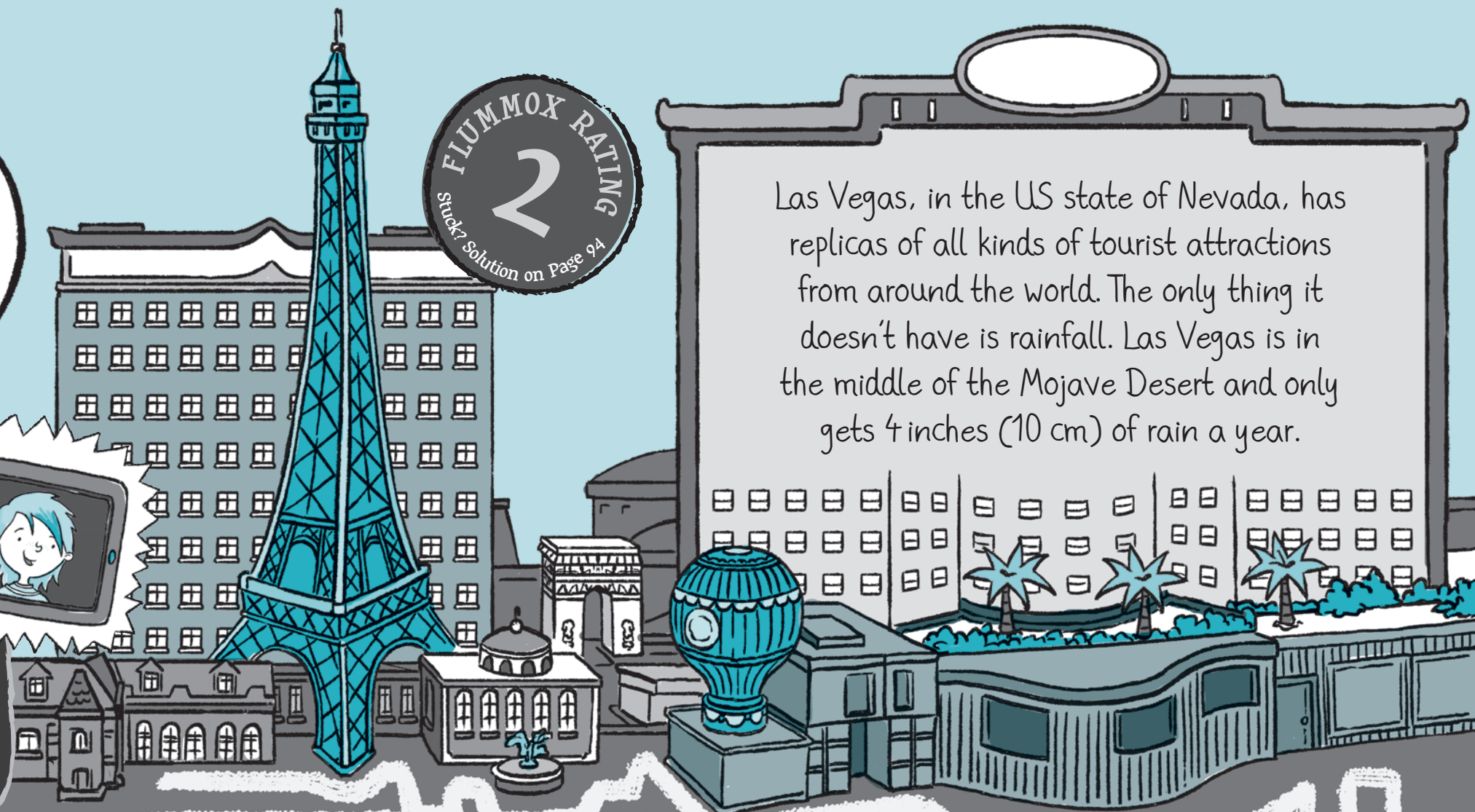

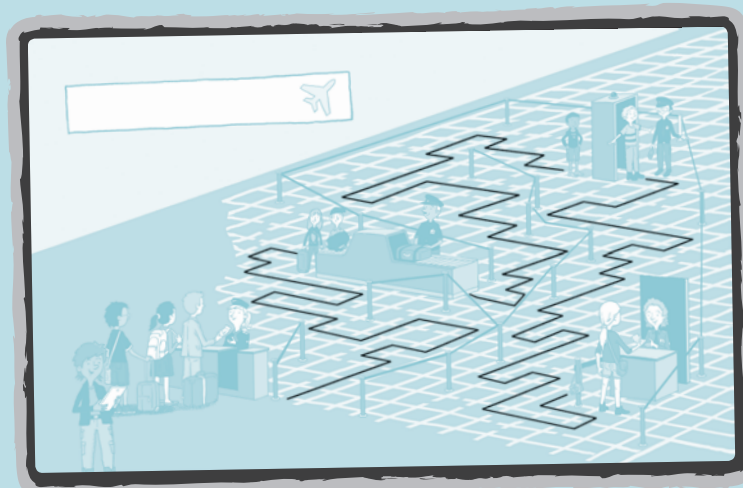
Whistler is named after a ground squirrel that makes a high-pitched warning call when it senses danger.



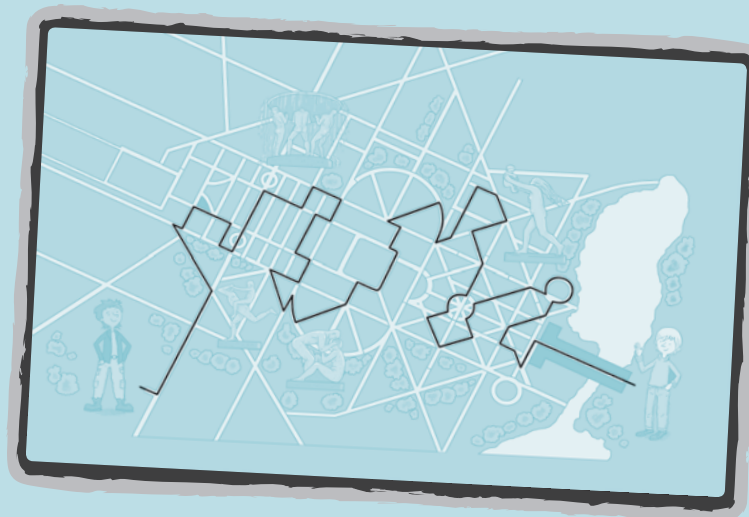

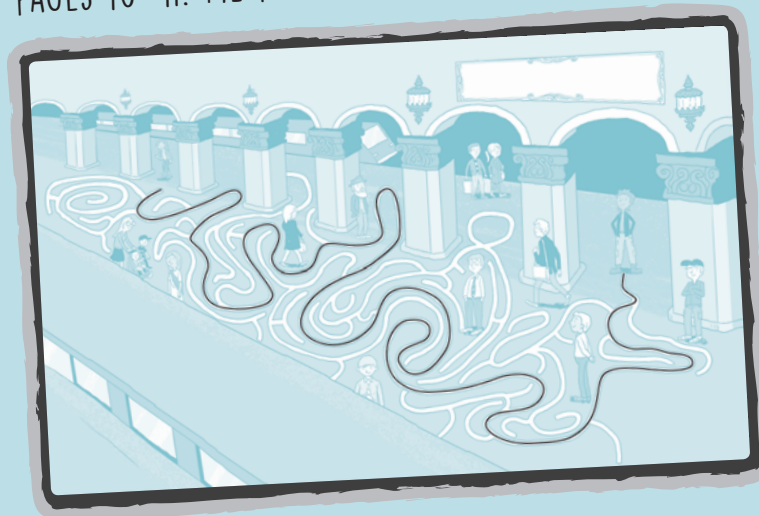

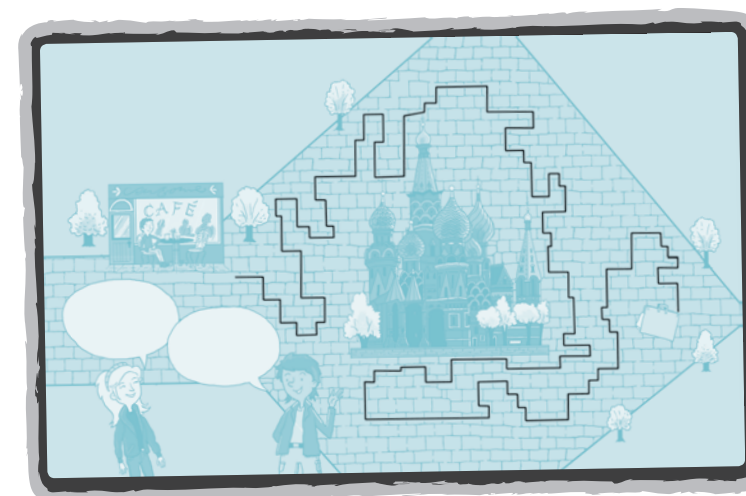

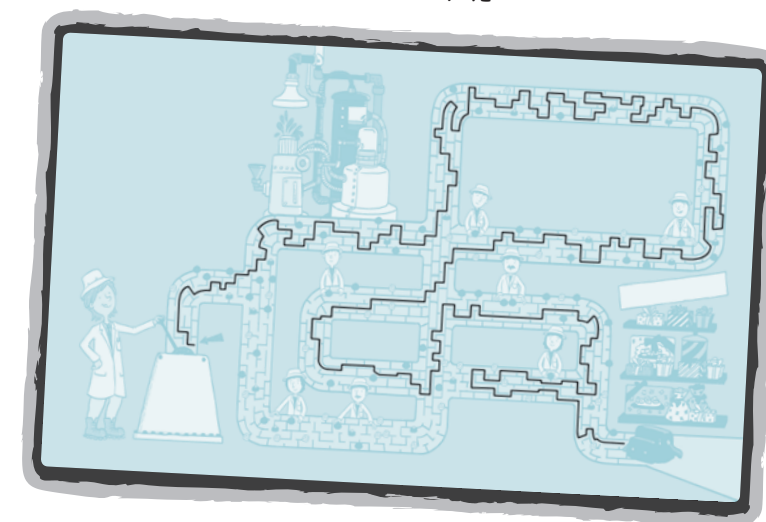

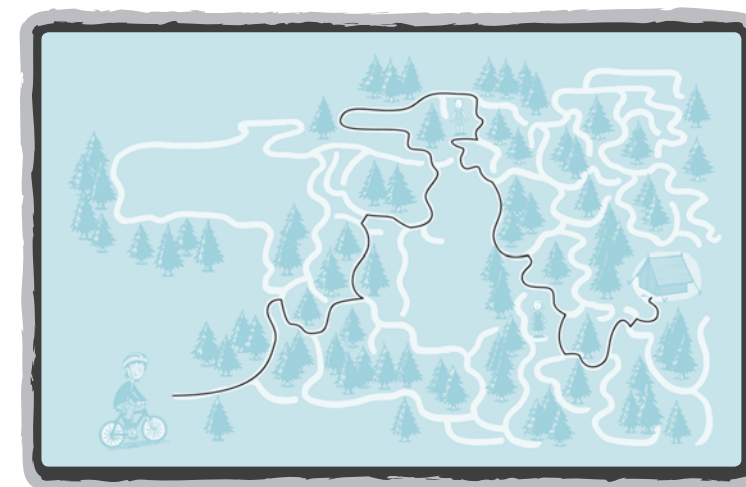
