
Why Go?


Unlike South Africa, Swaziland has managed to hold on to that slow-down-this-is-Africa feeling, and that's why it's gaining in popularity. Everything remains small and personable. Instead of making a flying visit here on your way to Kruger National Park, KwaZulu-Natal or Mozambique, consider staying at least a week to do the country justice. If you plan a visit during the winter months, try to make it coincide with the Umhlanga festival, one of Africa's biggest cultural events.

Dec-Apr Full rivers and lush vegetation. Incwala festival takes place in Lobamba. Feb-Mar Buganu season – enjoy home-brewed marula beer in rural Swaziland. May-Sep Wonderful wildlife viewing in the lowveld.

Swaziland Highlights

- Mkhaya Game Reserve (p964) Watching wildlife, including rare black rhinos, at this excellent reserve.
- 2 Malolotja Nature Reserve (p962) Walking or hiking in this enchanting wilderness area.
- 3 Great Usutu River (Lusutfu River; p965) Shooting
- over whitewater rapids on a day-long adventure.
- **4 Ezulwini Valley** (p959) Browsing the valley's craft shops.
- **5 Miliwane Wildlife Sanctuary** (p961) Exploring on foot, horseback or by bike and relaxing in the comfortable lodges.
- Sibebe Rock (p957) Climbing this massive granite dome just outside the capital and soaking up the lovely views.
- Thane Royal National Park (p963) Coming face-to-face with a pride of lions or watching white rhinos congregate at at the accessible watering hole.
