Wines of the Margaret River wine region dominate the southwest, which also just happens to be one of the best places to see whales if you're anywhere near Albany. Go a little further and Cape Le Grand and Fitzgerald River national parks have some of the best beaches in the country. Ningaloo Reef, Monkey Mia, the Dampier Peninsula and the Bungle Bungles are simply and utterly magnificent as well.
