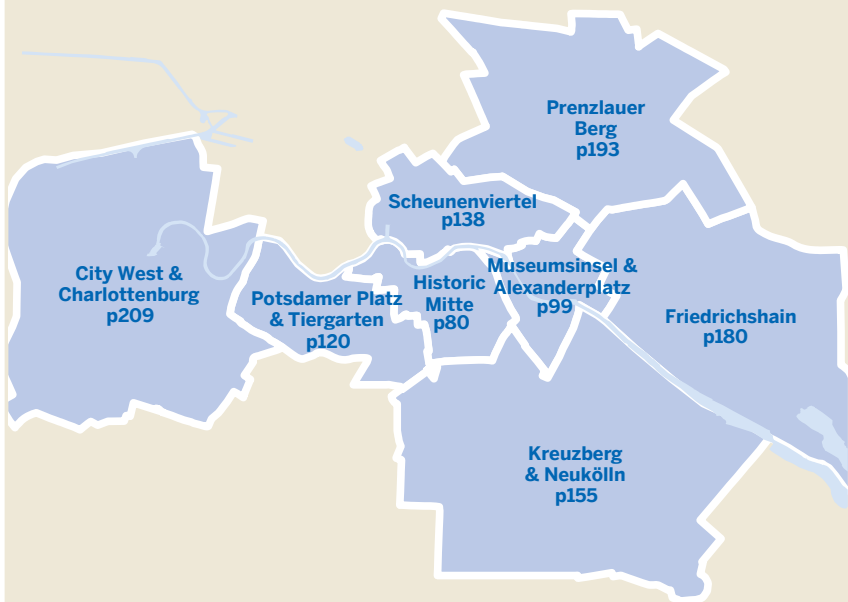

Top Itineraries

Day One

Historic Mitte (p80)

 One day in Berlin? Follow this whirlwind itinerary to take in all the key sights. Book ahead for an early lift ride up to the dome of the **Reichstag**, then snap a picture of the **Brandenburg Gate** before exploring the maze of the **Holocaust Memorial** and admiring the contemporary architecture of **Potsdamer Platz**. View the **Berlin Wall remnants**, then head to **Checkpoint Charlie** to ponder the full extent of the Cold War madness. Saunter up Friedrichstrasse to soak up the glory of **Gendarmenmarkt** before your lunch.

Museumsinsel & Alexanderplatz (p99)

 Follow Unter den Linden east to **Museumsinsel** and spend the afternoon marvelling at the antiquities in the **Pergamonmuseum**. Beer-o'clock! Head over to **Brauhaus Georgbräu**, a brewpub on the Spree River in the Nikolaiviertel.

Scheunenviertel (p138)

 Stroll over to the all-ages **Clärchens Ballhaus** for a spin on the dance floor or process the day's impressions over a prime cocktail at swanky-cool **Buck & Breck**.

Day Two

Prenzlauer Berg (p193)

 Spend a couple of hours coming to grips with what life in Berlin was like when the Wall still stood by exploring the **Gedenkstätte Berliner Mauer**. Take a quick spin around **Mauerpark**, then grab a coffee at **Bonanza Coffee Heroes** and poke around the boutiques on Kastanienallee.

Museumsinsel & Alexanderplatz (p99)

 Start the afternoon holding court with Queen Nefertiti and other treasures at the stunning **Neues Museum**, then relax while letting the sights drift by on a one-hour **river cruise** around Museumsinsel. Walk over to the **Berliner Dom**, into the crypt and then up the gallery to see how the rebuilt Prussian royal city palace – called **Humboldt Forum** – fits into the cityscape. Enjoy a swanky sundowner at eyelevel with the Fernsehturm (TV Tower) from the **Park Inn Panorama Terrasse**.

Kreuzberg & Neukölln (p155)

 After dinner, go bar-hopping around Kottbusser Tor, pulling up for cocktails at **Würgengel** or **Ora**, beer at **Möbel Olfe** or wine at **Otto Rink**.

Day Three

City West & Charlottenburg (p209)

 Day three starts at **Schloss Charlottenburg**, where the Neuer Flügel (New Wing) and the palace garden are essential stops. Take the bus to Zoologischer Garten and meditate upon the futility of war at the **Kaiser-Wilhelm-Gedächtniskirche**, then – assuming it's not Sunday – satisfy your shopping cravings along **Kurfürstendamm** and its side streets. Keep your wallet handy and drop by the **Bikini Berlin** shopping mall and **KaDeWe** department store.

Kreuzberg & Neukölln (p155)

 Spend an hour or two at the striking Daniel Libeskind-designed **Jüdisches Museum**, then head down to the wide open fields of **Tempelhofer Feld** to see how an old airport can be recycled into a sustainable park and playground. Have a break at the **Luftgarten** beer garden or

find a favourite cafe among the many in northern Neukölln.

Kreuzberg & Neukölln (p155)

 You're already in party central, so hit the bars on Weserstrasse and its side streets, then move on to the dance

Day Four

Potsdam (p223)

 There's plenty more to do in Berlin proper, but we recommend you spend the better part of the day exploring the parks and royal palaces in Potsdam, a mere 40-minute S-Bahn ride away. Buy online tickets for your favourite time slot to see **Schloss Sanssouci**, a rococo jewel of a palace. Afterwards, explore the surrounding park and its many smaller palaces at leisure. The **Chinesisches Haus** is a must see.

Potsdam (p223)

 If you're done with your park explorations, head to Potsdam's old town for a spin around the **Holländisches Viertel** (Dutch Quarter) or a take a look at the latest art exhibit at the dashing **Museum Barberini** before heading back to

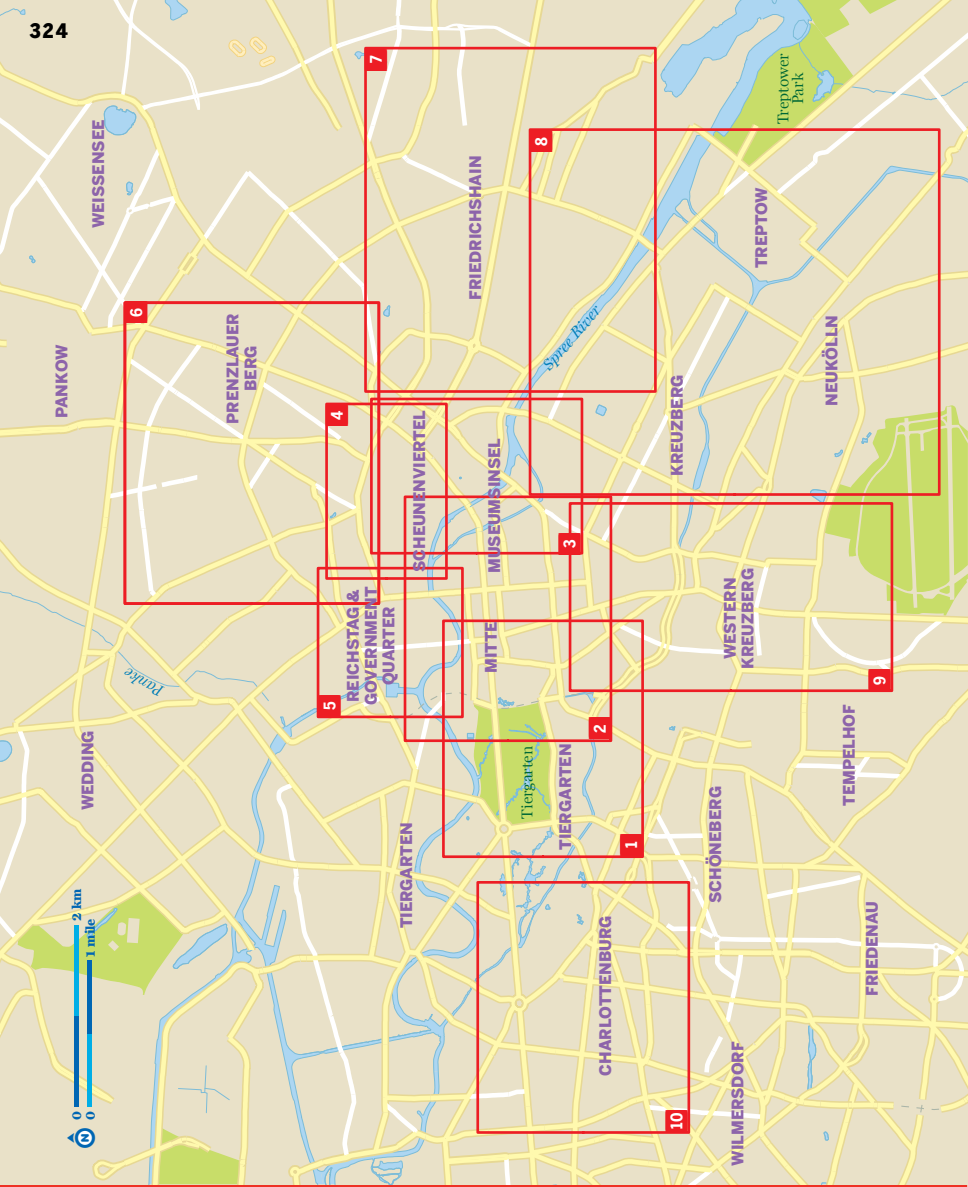
