The three volcanic peaks of Tongariro National Park provide a mighty backdrop for superb hiking and mountain biking, and from Taupo north to Rotorua the land is alive with the powerful geothermal forces. Rotorua is also a hot spot of traditional Māori culture, with the city's famed hangi feasts and concerts.

To the northwest, the Waitomo Caves offer relaxed exploration or more exciting adventures to challenge Rotorua's compelling menu of extreme activities, and funky Raglan is the quintessential Kiwi surf town.
