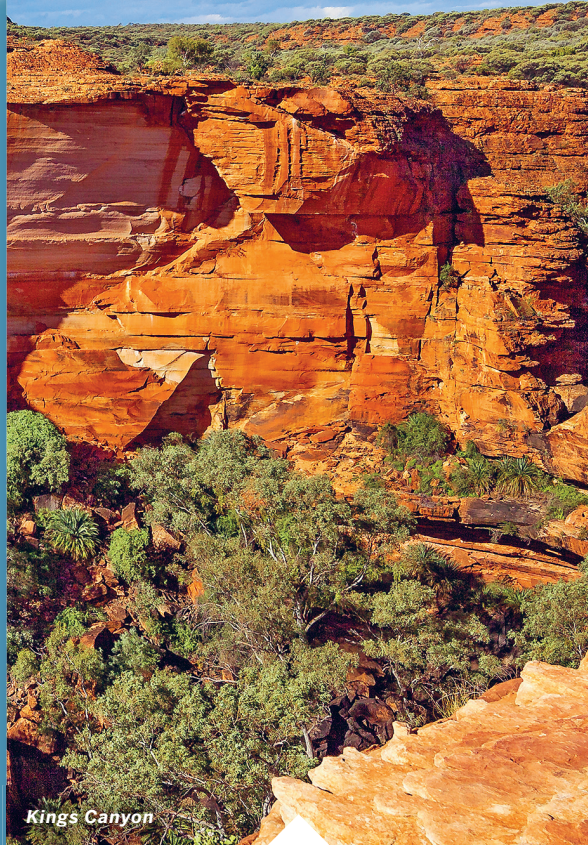




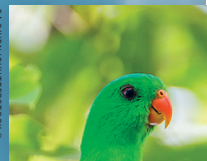

## DARWIN

Australia's only tropical capital city, Darwin gazes out across the Timor Sea. It's closer to Bali than Bondi and certainly feels a little different from the rest of the country – which is just how the locals like it.

### MINDIL BEACH SUNSET MARKET B1

As the sun dips behind the coconut palms during the dry season, Darwin locals migrate to this fabulous market, with its tribal beats and aromatically smoking food carts.

### MUSEUM & ART GALLERY OF THE NT B1

A superb facility with beautifully curated Top End exhibits. The Aboriginal art collection is a highlight, as is the room devoted to Cyclone Tracy, which levelled Darwin in 1974.

### ROYAL FLYING DOCTOR SERVICE B1

This outstanding museum features a hologram cinema, virtual-reality displays on the 1942 Japanese bombing of Darwin Harbour, and a map showing the current locations of RFDS planes.



## ROYAL FLYING DOCTOR SERVICE MINDIL BEACH SUNSET MARKET MUSEUM & ART GALLERY OF THE NT

**Beer Can Regatta**  
An insane festival at Mindil Beach in July, featuring races for boats made from beer cans.

**Crocosaurus Cove**  
Right in the middle of Darwin, get up close and personal with the amazing saltwater crocodile.

**Adelaide River Tours**  
Crocs, kangaroos, buffalos and charismatic birds – the pick of the tours on the Adelaide River.

**Jatbula Trail**  
An intense, five-day jaunt through 66 rugged kilometres of prime NT wilderness.

**Cutta Cutta Caves Nature Park**  
Escape the searing sun and dip 15m below terra firma into these mazelike limestone caves.

**Victoria River Crossing**  
One of the Territory's least-known but prettier corners, with gorgeous escarpment country nearby.

**Daly Waters Pub**  
The NT's oldest pub (1893) is pasted with business cards, bras, banknotes and memorabilia.

**Tiwi Islands**  
A visit to the Tiwis, 80km north of Darwin, is a Top End cultural highlight.

**Arnhemlander Cultural & Heritage Centre**  
Aboriginal-owned and -operated tours into Arnhem Land – a great way of exploring this remote region.

**Ubirr**  
Ubirr's rock-art galleries are a soulful history book telling Kakadu's extraordinary human and natural stories.

**Barrk Walk**  
A challenging 12km day-walk through the Nourlangie area, with art and sensational views.

**Ghunmarn Culture Centre**  
One of the Territory's best: excellent art and culture displays from West Arnhem Land.
