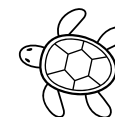

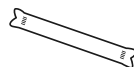
## THE NATIONAL STADIUM, SINGAPORE

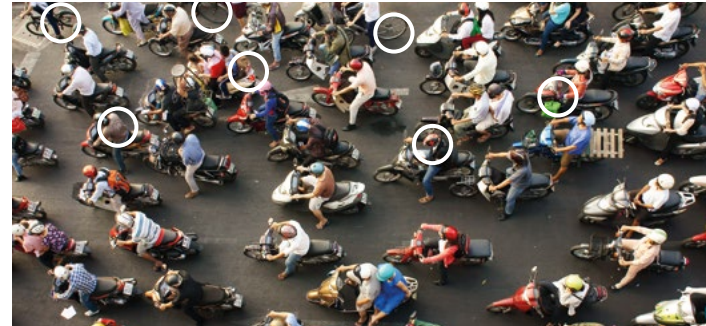

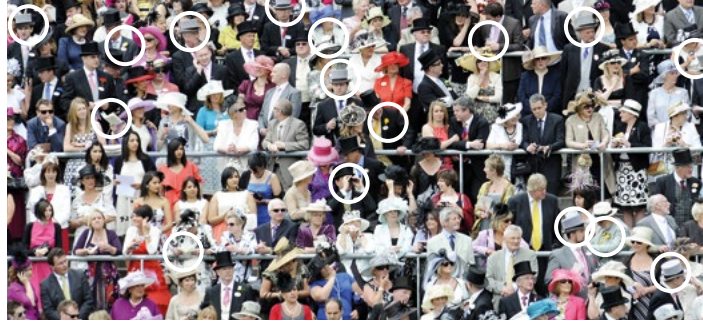
