You'll need some scarecrows to stop the birds from eating all your hard work!


MITTING

Use your stickers to add some more birds flying away.







Now draw a scarecrow of your own in this field.

What an enormous carrot! In the space above, draw more people helping Marco and Amelia to pull it out of the ground.




Once you've finished drawing, stick more rabbits in the tunnels and chambers.

Draw more hills in the background. Then add some other details to them, such as trees and animals.






These geese


TERRIFIC TRACTORS

You'll need a superstrong set of wheels to drive around your farm!


All tractor drivers need a licence.

Follow these simple step-by-step instructions to draw a tractor for your farm.




Draw your own tractor in the space below. Trace over the wheels to start you off.




Once you have drawn your tractor, colour it in with your felt-tip pens.


