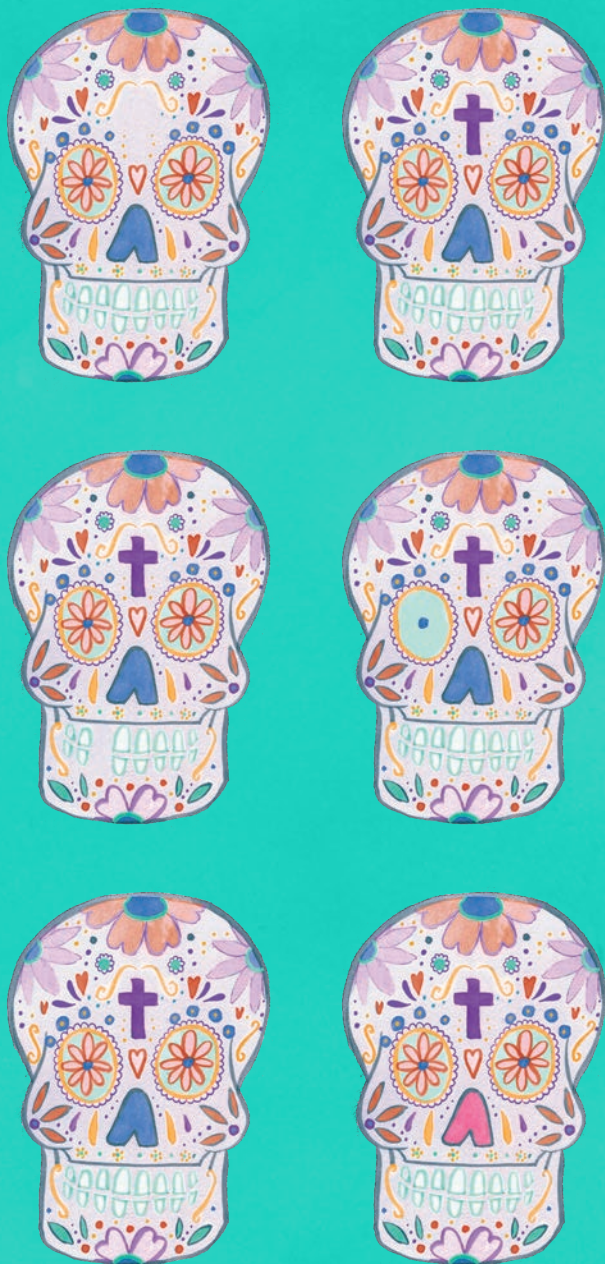
DRAW IN FACES AND ADD STICKERS!

Masked wrestling, known as *lucha libre*, is a popular Mexican sport, famed for its colourful costumes. Colour in and design your own fearsome mask!



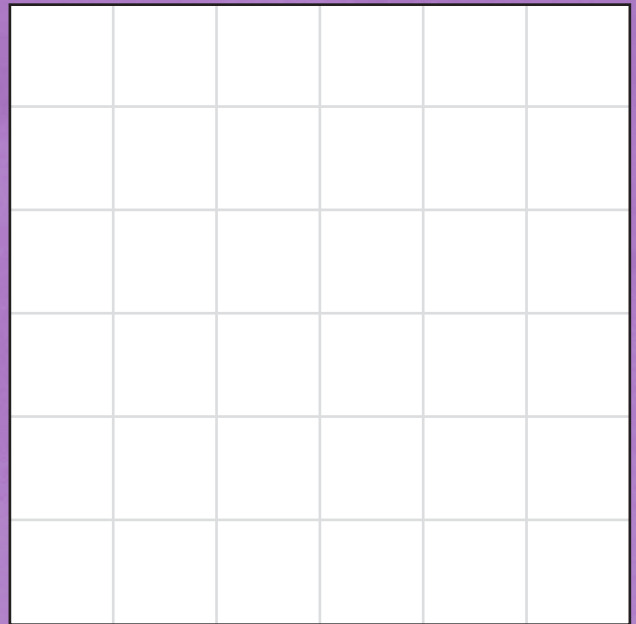
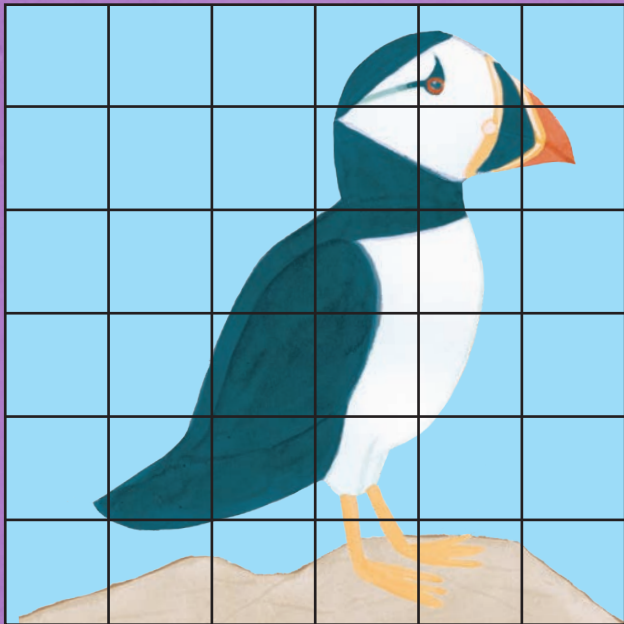
REYKJAVÍK
