Why Go?


The quieter northern section of Turkey's Aegean coast is the ideal destination for anyone who wants to relax in the sun – without getting stuck on the beach. There are beaches, of course – such as those on Bozcaada – but the hills and peninsulas are also rich in history and culture. There's the remains of Troy, hilltop ruins in Bergama and Behramkale, and, around the latter, communities descended from Turkmen nomads.

Perhaps the most poignant piece of local history is the population exchange between Turkey and Greece. In spots such as Ayvalık and Bozcaada town, you might hear elderly people chatting in Greek as you wander through the picturesque old Greek quarter.

The local city, İzmir, is a laid-back place with plenty of sights around its bazaar and waterfront. It's also the gateway to the Çeşme Peninsula, where Alaçatı offers the greatest concentration of the region's many boutique hotels.
