## CENTRAL WEST COAST

The pristine coastline and sheltered turquoise waters of World Heritage-listed Shark Bay draw tourists and marine life from around the world. To the north, the astonishing 300km-long reef within Ningaloo Marine Park rivals the Great Barrier Reef in the biodiversity stakes.

### MONKEY MIA B3

Monkey Mia's wild dolphins are famous, but this is also a place to roam absentmindedly along the beach, meet a pelican and swim in gin-clear water. You can also hire pedal boats, kayaks and stand-up paddleboards, or go snorkelling.

### SHARK BAY B3

On mainland Australia's westernmost point, Shark Bay's World Heritage environment includes 1500km of dazzling coastline: turquoise lagoons, barren finger-like peninsulas, hidden bays, white-sand beaches, towering limestone cliffs and many islands.

### NINGALOO MARINE PARK B2

You'll be hard-pressed to find words that do justice to the pristine, aquarium-like waters and pure sands of Ningaloo, Australia's largest fringing reef. The fact that it abuts the arid, rugged Cape Range National Park simply adds to the appeal.

### PINNACLES DESERT B4

Around 14km from Cervantes, Nambung National Park hosts the eye-popping Pinnacles Desert, an alien-like plain studded with jaunty limestone pillars rising eerily from the dunes. Drive or explore on foot: it's especially atmospheric in the twilight when the crowds evaporate.

**Turtle-Viewing Tour**  
The ecologically safe way to see nesting turtles is on a Parks & Wildlife-guided tour.

**Bill's Bay**  
Easy access and sheltered teal waters make Bill's a favourite with families and snorkellers.

## NINGALOO MARINE PARK

**Turquoise Beach**  
A perfect sweep of powdery-white sand lapped by azure (turquoise!) waters – one of Australia's best beaches.

**Gnaraloo Bay**  
This white-sand crescent is truly gorgeous. Snorkel in cerulean waters, traverse the cape or kitesurf.

**Tombstones**  
One of the world's longest, roundest, meanest tubes. Tombstones is a surfing essential.

## SHARK BAY

**Ngurrangga Tours**  
Cultural and rock-art tours in Murujuga National Park in the Pilbara, departing from Karratha.

**East Pilbara Arts Centre**  
This striking centre beautifully showcases the acclaimed works of the Martumili artists.
